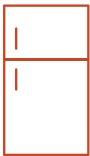
For the First Time, the Camera Goes Inside the Range

Through a specialized, built-in sensor, the CAFÉ induction slide-in range allows the cook to set a precise temperature and maintain that consistency right on the cooktop via integration with the GE Appliances Kitchen Hub or through the CAFÉ app on phones or tablets.

The new features will be available beginning August 2019 in the Stainless finish from the CAFÉ Customizable Professional Collection and in other finishes within CAFÉ collections.

Drop the Dish Towel, New Tech Dries Dishes Better

GE Appliances introduces Dual Convection technology—the first of its kind in the industry—to dry dishes more effectively.

Most heat dishwasher models have either an inlet fan/heater or an exhaust fan. GE Appliances models with Dual Convection have both. At the end of each wash cycle, the inlet fan pushes preheated, dry air into the dishwasher. Simultaneously, the exhaust fan pulls moisture out of the dishwasher, reducing the buildup of condensation. The result is dishes that are up to 90 percent dry, without adding time to the cycle—**drier than ever available before in a non-commercial product.**
