COMPOSITION OF AN AVERAGE BILL

4% Public Purpose Programs

Mandated state programs, including incentives for energy efficiency and protection for low-income customers



11% Wildfire

Covered conductor, vegetation clearing, enhanced inspections, weather stations, HD cameras and insurance



11% Taxes

Federal, state, county and city taxes and uncollectibles



6% Transmission

Investment in operations and maintenance for high-voltage transmission lines



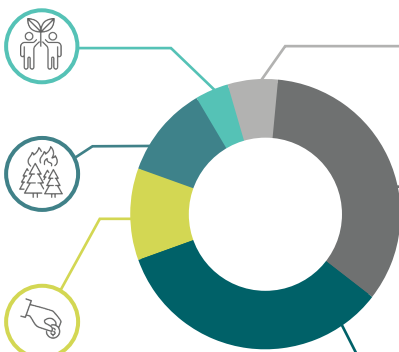
34% Distribution

Grid maintenance and new equipment, including poles, wires and substations

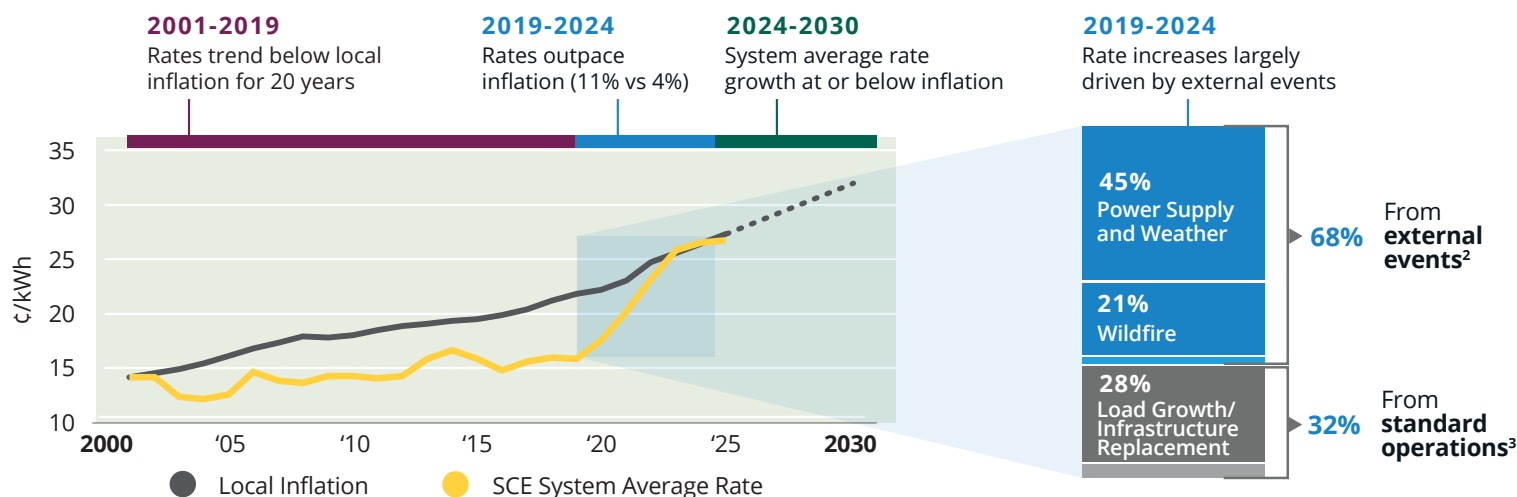


34% Power Supply

Cost of energy sources, including natural gas, hydro, solar and wind

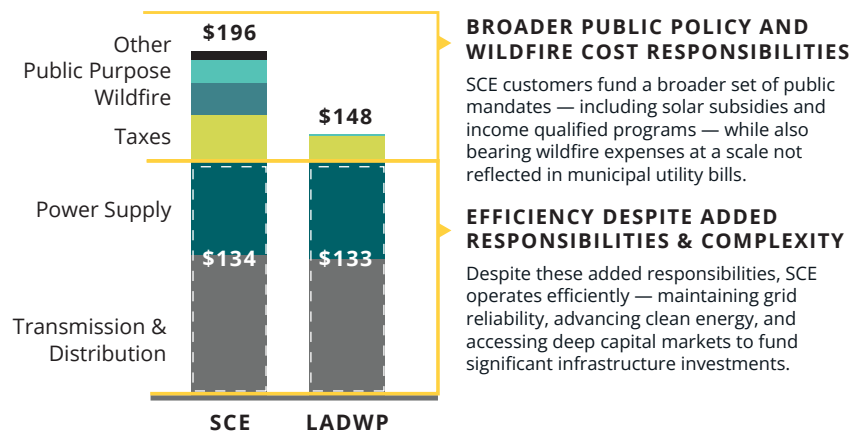


SCE RATES COMPARED TO INFLATION¹



SCE RESIDENTIAL BILLS COMPARED TO LADWP⁴

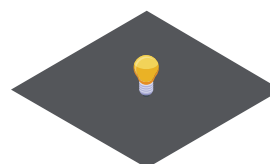
\$ per Month; Non-CARE; 500 kWh Consumption



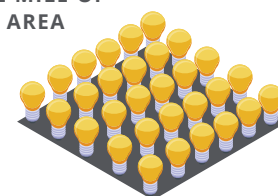
MORE COMPLEX SERVICE AREA

Taxes include Federal & State Income Tax, Property Tax, Franchise Fees & Uncollectibles and Utility Users Tax (UUT), a city-leveled tax collected on customer bills and remitted to local governments. Public Purpose includes CARE surcharge and extension of Diablo Canyon costs.
