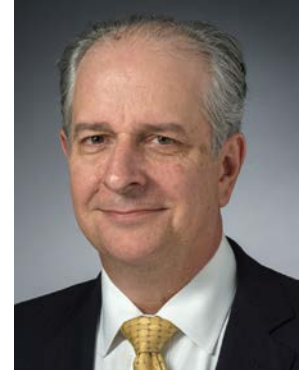


Jeff McCray
