### Duke Energy in Florida



Duke Energy (NYSE: DUK), a Fortune 150 company headquartered in Charlotte, N.C., is one of the largest energy holding companies in the U.S.

Duke Energy is transforming its customers' experience, modernizing the energy grid, generating cleaner energy and expanding natural gas infrastructure to create a smarter energy future for the people and communities it serves.

The company provides electricity to 7.7 million retail electric customers in six states. The electric service area's estimated population is 24 million people.

The company also provides natural gas to more than 1.6 million customers in five states and operates wind and solar power facilities in 14 states.

Duke Energy began serving customers in Florida more than a century ago – and at the very foundation of our company is a commitment to serve our customers and communities.

- Serving Florida since 1899.
- We serve approximately 1.8 million retail accounts, bringing electricity to more than 4 million people and businesses in 35 counties.
- 13,000 service territory square miles.
- Approximately 5,200 miles of transmission lines. Distribution system includes approximately 18,000 miles of overhead distribution and approximately 14,000 circuit miles of underground distribution cable.
- 19 power generation sites capable of producing nearly 10,200 megawatts of electricity.

- Approximately 3,800 employees and more than 3,375 retirees.
