Duke Energy (NYSE: DUK), a Fortune 150 company headquartered in Charlotte, N.C., is one of the largest energy holding companies in the U.S.

Duke Energy is transforming its customers' experience, modernizing the energy grid, generating cleaner energy and expanding natural gas infrastructure to create a smarter energy future for the people and communities it serves.

The company provides electricity to 7.7 million retail electric customers in six states. The electric service area's estimated population is 24 million people.

The company also provides natural gas to more than 1.6 million customers in five states, and operates wind and solar power facilities in 14 states.

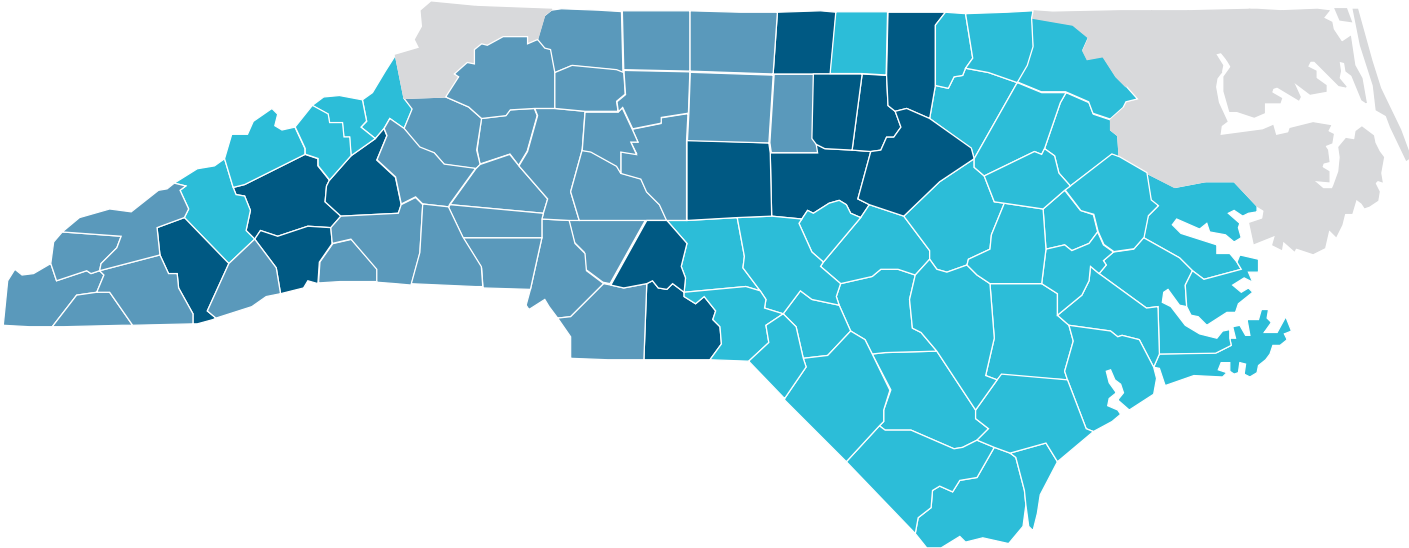
- In 2018, Duke Energy donated more than \$27 million to charitable causes in North Carolina
