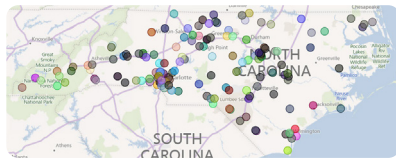

Helping communities thrive and grow

- The company paid **\$174 million** in property taxes in 2019. These supported schools, first responders and infrastructure needs in the communities we serve.
- Duke Energy helped attract **4,280 jobs** and **\$3.3 billion** in capital investment to North Carolina in 2019.
- In 2019, Duke Energy spent more than **\$1.7 billion** with North Carolina suppliers, representing about 34.7% of the company's total local spend of \$4.9 billion for the same time frame. The spend with diverse North Carolina businesses was more than \$316 million.
- The direct spend in North Carolina in 2019 was **\$2.63 billion**, which increased local employment and provided positive direct, indirect and induced economic impact for the state.

Giving back

- The Duke Energy Foundation donated nearly **\$22 million** across the states we serve in 2019. In North Carolina alone, the Foundation donated **\$12 million** through more than **420 grants** related to K-12 education, workforce, nature and other areas of state and community impact.
- Duke Energy employees donated more than **61,000 hours** to North Carolina volunteer projects in 2019.
