



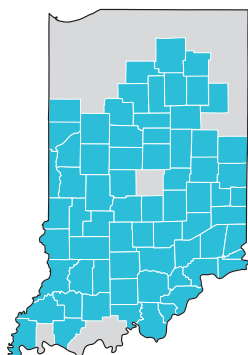
At a Glance / INDIANA

Duke Energy Indiana, a subsidiary of Duke Energy, provides about 6,300 megawatts of owned electric capacity to approximately 920,000 customers in a 23,000-square-mile service area, making it Indiana's largest electric supplier.

At the very foundation of our company is a commitment to serve our customers. We energize our communities and enhance the quality of life for people who live here.

- 920,000 retail customers
- We are the largest electric utility in Indiana with operations headquartered in Plainfield, Ind., providing electric service in 69 of the state's 92 counties.
- In December 2022, we completed a transaction with GIC – a leading global investment firm run by the government of Singapore – for the acquisition of a 19.9% minority interest in Duke Energy Indiana.

State-Specific Operational Facts

- More than 38,000 miles of transmission and distribution lines
- Total capacity of 6,400 megawatts, which includes 12 power generation sites as well as long-term power purchase agreements, and is composed of 59% coal-fired, 29% natural gas-fired, 9% syngas-fired, 2% wind, and less than 1% each of oil-fired, hydro-powered, solar and battery

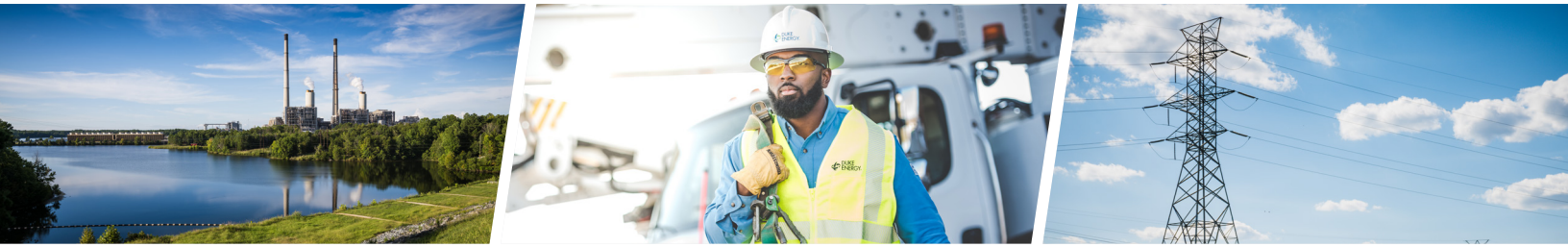
- Paid more than \$59 million in property and use taxes in 2024

Economic Development in Indiana

- In 2024, Duke Energy helped recruit \$7 billion in capital investment and more than 2,800 new jobs to Indiana.
- We invested more than \$635,000 in our partnerships with local, regional and state economic development organizations to help attract businesses to Indiana in 2024.
- In 2024, we increased our Duke Energy Site Readiness portfolio to 47 sites. Since the beginning of the program, we have invested more than \$1.3 million to prepare sites for new economic development opportunities to grow the communities we serve.

Giving in Indiana

- In 2024, Duke Energy Indiana awarded nearly \$2.1 million in shareholder-funded grants from the Duke Energy Foundation.
- In 2024, Duke Energy Indiana employees and retirees contributed more than \$274,000 to charitable organizations and nearly 13,900 hours of volunteer time. The company match for employee giving and volunteerism was just over \$411,000.
- In 2024, we dedicated over \$650,000 in financial assistance through our Share the Light Fund® to support customers struggling to pay their electric bills.
