RENOWNED AILEY DANCERS AND CHOREOGRAPHERS LEAD WORKSHOPS AT THE AILEY EXTENSION IN CONJUNCTION WITH ALVIN AILEY AMERICAN DANCE THEATER'S MILESTONE 60TH ANNIVERSARY NEW YORK CITY CENTER SEASON

Workshops with Leading Dancers Linda Celeste Sims and Jamar Roberts on November 3 and November 19, Distinguished Choreographers Rennie Harris and Ronald K. Brown on November 4 and December 5

(New York, NY) October 31, 2018 - In celebration of Alvin Ailey American Dance Theater's momentous 60th Anniversary, Ailey Extension extends an invitation to dancers of all levels and backgrounds to join workshops by Company dancers and choreographers featured in the New York City Center holiday season (November 28-December 30). Acclaimed Ailey stars Linda Celeste Sims and Jamar Roberts lead Contemporary workshops that will unite Modern dance principles with the exploration of artistic range, and renowned choreographers Rennie Harris and Ronald K. Brown will offer an immersive taste of upcoming season world premieres and their respective signature styles. Ailey Extension workshops are open to participants of all experience levels.

For the first time, celebrated Ailey dancer <u>Linda Celeste Sims</u> comes to Ailey Extension for a two-hour Contemporary Modern Workshop on **Saturday, November 3 at 4pm**, designed to give dancers the opportunity to find freedom and joy in movement. A Dance Magazine Award Honoree and Bessie Award recipient with a professional career spanning more than two decades, Mrs. Sims is recognized globally for her memorable performances and her lyrical musicality, endless extensions, absolute precision, and grace. This one-time-only workshop incorporates modern dance techniques such as Graham, Horton, Taylor, and Jazz with Ballet principles, providing students with the necessary technical tools to expand their movement.

Legendary choreographer and Alvin Ailey American Dance Theater's inaugural artist-in-residence Rennie Harris leads a two-hour advanced study of Street dance on Sunday, November 4 at 5pm. Reflective of Mr. Harris' personal style and philosophy, his workshop will offer dancers a fundamental Street dance foundation and working knowledge of rhythm, groove rhythm and movement. In addition, Mr. Harris will contextualize Street dance aesthetic and culture though personal stories, experience, and history. The workshop offers connection to the upcoming world premiere of Mr. Harris' Lazarus, the Company's first two-act ballet, which calls on inspiration from the life and legacy of Mr. Ailey and addresses the racial inequalities our nation has faced in 1958 when the Company was founded and today. This workshop is free to the public.

Company dancer and choreographer <u>Jamar Roberts</u> joins Ailey Extension for his inaugural Contemporary workshop on **Monday, November 19 at 7pm**. With an emphasis on opposition and resistance in movement, participants will be challenged to better understand weight, gravity, and articulation in the use of the body. The workshop begins with a warm-up based in Graham and Limon principles, combined with Mr. Robert's own unique movement style, before journeying through movement aimed to promote synergy between technical dance and individual expression. Throughout the workshop, dancers are encouraged to connect movement to their breath and physical sensations, allowing them to engage with a more dynamic sense of musicality and a consistent flow of energy.

On **Wednesday, December 5 at 7pm**, dancers will have the opportunity to learn from Ronald K. Brown, one of today's most preeminent choreographers, as he transports his renowned storytelling from the stage to the Ailey studios. On December 3, Mr. Brown will receive the prestigious 2018 Dance Magazine Award, ahead of the world premiere of <u>The Call</u> on December 4, his newest work for Alvin Ailey American Dance Theater. His master class fuses modern dance technique with West African movements, including traditional and social dance from the United States, Senegal, Cuba, and Ivory Coast. Designed for people with a wide range of dance experience, participants will develop their versatility and ability to organically move from one style to the next.

Alvin Ailey American Dance Theater's 60th Anniversary season at New York City Center features premieres from some of today's most celebrated choreographers, including Rennie Harris, Ronald K. Brown, Wayne McGregor, and Jessica Lang, along with timeless treasures by Alvin Ailey. The season also included the long-awaited new production of Artistic Director Robert Battle's <u>Juba</u>, his first work for the Company created in 2003.
