- International fleet has grown nearly 30 percent since 2013

Best-In-Class Aircraft

- G500 earned U.S. Federal Aviation Administration type certification on July 20, 2018; first delivery was September 27, 2018
- Enhanced performance capabilities for both aircraft
 - G500: 5,200 nm / 9,630 km at Mach 0.85*
 - G500: 4,400 nm / 8,149 km at Mach 0.90*
 - G600: 6,500 nm / 12,038 km at Mach 0.85*
 - G600: 5,500 nm / 10,186 km at Mach 0.90*
- New Gulfstream Symmetry Flight Deck™ with industry-first Active Control Sidesticks (ACS)
- Five G600 flight-test aircraft have more than 700 flights, accumulating more than 2,600 flight-test hours
