Advancing Spent Fuel Removal from Site

David Victor

- **Legislation**
 - House Energy & Commerce Committee staff stated intent to consider spent fuel storage legislation, likely focused on consolidated interim storage (CIS)
 - Timing is later in 2019
- **Appropriations**
 - Rep. Doris Matsui (D-CA) submitted CIS funding request in House E&W Appropriations bill with support from others in Democratic Caucus
 - Later this year, Senate E&W Appropriations Chairman, Sen. Alexander (R-TN), plans to include CIS funding in the Senate E&W Appropriations bill
 - Expect \$10 million for one or more CIS pilot projects
