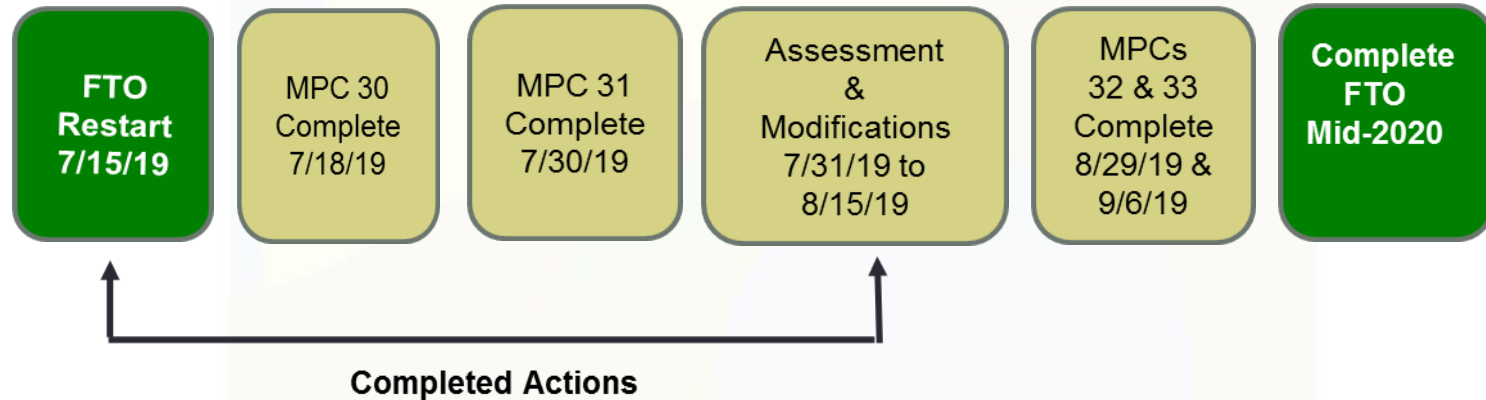
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Fuel Transfer Operations Status and Forecast

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Multi Purpose Canisters 30 & 31 Summary

- Good focus on safety and coaching
- Effective pre-job briefs and turnovers
- Low threshold for use of Corrective Action Program
- Early identification of issues and prompt resolution
- Schedule pressure not an issue
- Open communication and interactive participation
- Comprehensive and widespread feedback



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Multi Purpose Canisters 30 & 31 Lessons Learned

- Bolt thread issue: Spare parts and procedural improvement
- Procedural Misunderstanding: Mating Device Door
- Addressing stored Multi Purpose Canister (MPC) rain water intrusion



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Status Summary

- No serious safety or human performance issues
- Good teamwork
- Healthy and effective relationship between Holtec and SCE
- NRC presence for Fuel Transfer Operation (FTO) activities
- Continuous improvement actions are in process
 - Procedure revisions to improve clarity
 - Equipment upgrades
