## **STORMWATER MONITORING & INSPECTION**





Cobb County Stormwater Management Water Quality Section inspects and monitors stormwater outfalls and easements to assess the condition of the storm sewer system and its ability to function during rain events. To protect water quality, the Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination (IDDE) program

looks for illegal connections to the system and/or unauthorized discharges. Additionally, the Highly Visible Pollutant Sources (HVPS) program inspects local business with high potential to impact water quality. Inspectors visit places such as auto repair shops, car washes and kennels to identify potential stormwater pollution sources or behaviors that could contribute to point source stormwater pollution.

Stormwater Operations and Maintenance inspects and maintains an inventory of Cobb County owned storm sewer infrastructure. Utilizing modern technology, infrastructure is located, evaluated, and video inspected in order to assess condition and ability to function during rain events.
