Reallocation of Unexpended CDBG Program Funds

The Cobb County CDBG Program Office will hold a Virtual Public Review Meeting on **Wednesday, April 6, 2022 at 11:00 a.m.** to receive comments on the reallocation of unexpended **Program Years (PY) 2019, 2020, and 2021 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)** program funds.

A total of **\$310,000.00** in CDBG funds from various subrecipient projects is available for reallocation. In compliance with this HUD regulation of timely expenditures, our Office is recommending a reallocation of program funds to **Zion Keepers, Inc.** for the acquisition and renovation of the property located at 1450 Austell Rd SE in Marietta, GA 30008 where services will be provided for low-income persons.

The proposed funding recommendations will be included on the Tuesday, April 26, 2022 Cobb County Board of Commissioners Agenda.
