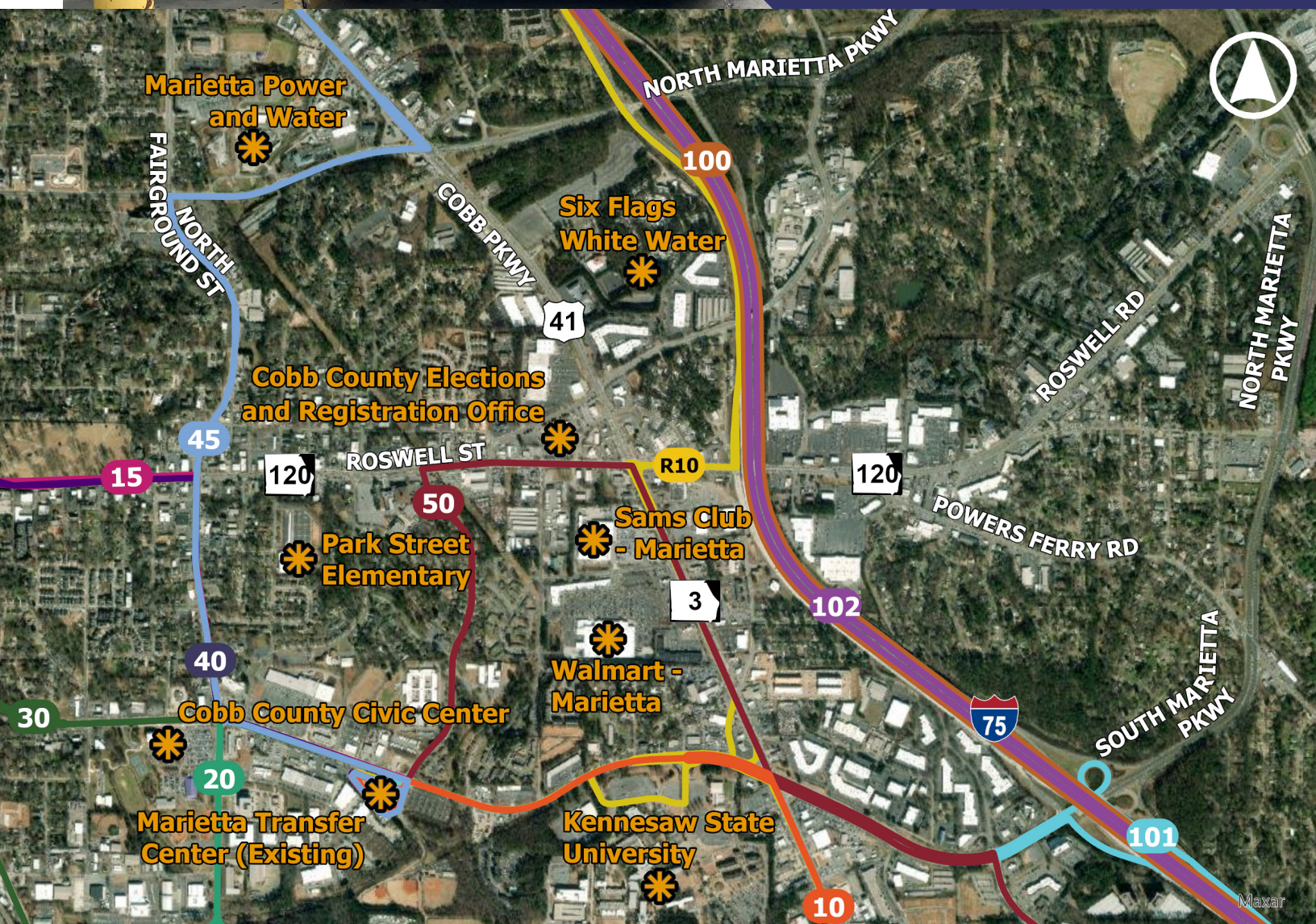


MARIETTA TRANSIT CENTER SITE SELECTION STUDY

BACKGROUND

Cobb County Department of Transportation (CCDOT) and CobbLinc have initiated a series of studies to develop planning-level programming needs for three transit centers. The County is proposing to expand and relocate the existing CobbLinc transfer facilities at Cumberland and Marietta and develop a third facility in the South Cobb area.

The Marietta Transit Center Site Selection Study builds on the CobbForward Comprehensive Transportation Plan 2050 and is a first step in developing a new and state-of-the-art multimodal transit center for CobbLinc services. The transit center is envisioned to enhance connections to the CobbLinc network of public transportation service while at the same time providing for enhanced accessibility to regional and local multimodal transportation options.
