Jenny Xu, Finance Department briefed the committee on the 2022 SPLOST Revenue Summary and included financial updates on the 2011, 2016 and 2022 SPLOST programs. 2022 SPLOST revenues collected are \$225 million over budget. Projected collections based on a 12-month average are \$1,058,464,472 — over budget by \$308,464,472. Collections based on a 24-month average are projected to be \$1,063,217,255 — over budget by \$313,217,255. Both, the 12-month average and 24-month average project 7 months to reach the budget of \$750 million. Unobligated remaining funds for the 2011 and 2016 SPLOST are as follows: 2011 - \$5.6 million, 2016 - \$29.8 million.
