## **Cobb Water Publishes 2025 Annual Water Quality Report**

Marietta, GA – Cobb County Water System (CCWS) is pleased to announce that the 2025 Water Quality Report, also known as the Consumer Confidence Report (CCR), is now available. CCWS remains committed to delivering clean, reliable drinking water to its customers. This annual report provides detailed information about the quality of the drinking water supplied to our customers, as required by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

CCWS purchases its drinking water from the Cobb County-Marietta Water Authority (CCMWA), a public utility providing potable water on a wholesale basis. The report includes data from laboratory testing conducted by CCMWA from January to December 2024. It demonstrates that the water provided by CCMWA, and distributed by CCWS, continues to meet or exceed all federal and state drinking water quality requirements.

Inside the report, in addition to the latest lab results, you will find information about your drinking water sources, water infrastructure, your role in water quality, and unregulated contaminant monitoring.
