### • SPLOST Budget Update:

2011 Projects – 98% Completed: 2% Future Projects. (Fullers, Hyde, and Mt. Bethel)

2016 Projects – 97% Completed; 2% Design; 1% Under Construction; 2% Future Project (Future Project: Hyde) All projects are underway currently.
2022 Projects – 62% Future; 28% Completed; >10% Construction Underway; <6% Design/Engineering (Future Projects: Ebenezer Downs, Shaw Park, Al Bishop Synthetic Turf & LED Lights Upgrade, and Price Bridge)

Project Summary: 2011

- SPLOST Budget Update:
- Various Projects
  - Fullers Field 1 Infield synthetic turf replacement: 5 bids received. Will go in front of the BOC on 6/10.
  - Power-Jackson Cabin is permitted. We are working on site work bids.

# Rhyne Park

- Paint on all structures, LED conversion on Field 1 and turf install on Fields 2 & 4 are complete.
- Grading on Field 1 has begun.
- Concrete sidewalks install continues and fencing will continue once other trades are out of the way.
- The entry sign will be installed by the end of May.
- Work to be fully completed by end of June.

# Hyde Farm Pavilion

• Building is in production and should be onsite by mid-June. The install is set to start in July. The pavilion is 32'x 20', located adjacent to the maintenance barn.

# Milford Recreation Center

The grand opening is this Saturday. The punch list is near completion.
 FF&E continues to be delivered. We are waiting on Comcast to bring internet to the building.

Project Summary: 2022

- Terrell Mill Restroom/Pavilion
  - Submitted permitting on 5/9 for 4 separate family style restrooms, a 1500 sq ft pavilion and ADA connection to the existing playground walkway.

# P-ARPA Fair Oaks/ Booth Road:

- Stakeholder feedback and Design Development are complete. We are moving to construction documents.
- Fair Oaks- 1 Synthetic Turf MP Field, 6 Pickleball courts gravel walking track lighting upgrade, fencing, and resurfacing the basketball goals with new goals.
- Booth Road Practice Cricket Pitch (like a batting cage), hybrid Cricket Field, asphalt parking lot, entry improvements, playground, and restroom facility.

# Swingtime Access Road – FY 23 Project

- Contractor, Bartow Paving, has completed clearing and grubbing, curb and gutter, and GAB for access road. The duration for completion- within 6 months- is on track.
- Reminder: The Swingtime parking lot is closed during construction.
   Temporary parking for disc golf is provided via gravel lot at the Oregon Park entrance.

### Various Projects:

- Civic Center Staging Received stage decks; still waiting on other equipment.
- Civic Center Stage lighting- Equipment received, awaiting install.
- East Cobb Bridge Renovations Materials received. Elk Construction will begin work on 5/24. The bridge will be close for approximately 2 months.
- Mable House Amphitheatre Reno Pricing with Unit Price contractors. The PO was issued for the 20'x40' LED screen.
- Mable House Historic area Concrete The PO was issued.

- Miller Projectors Equipment received and installed. We are awaiting the programmer to program system.
- Art Place Lighting Equipment received, awaiting install.

Michael Brantley <a href="PARKS Update">PARKS Update</a>:

Michael shared today was the first BOC meeting with the new 5-member commission. Commissioner Eric Allen was sworn in last week. The Public Services Department has plans to meet with the new commissioner and bring him up to speed with the happenings of District 2. Michael also shared information about the Revenue Above Projections (RAP) happening this fall and how it will impact future and incomplete SPLOST projects. PARKS is also in their final preparation for Summer Camp.

Finally, Michael shared some of his important takeaways from the Department Head Retreat which included leveraging AI to improve PARKS.

Chair Demetrius Lockett and Co-Chair Jill Flamm shared Joe Atkins relationship with Cobb County Parks and Recreation as a liaison to the Marietta Galleria Forum. They requested Joe come in to the July or August Rec Board meeting and share updates on what the Galleria authority is doing. *Elliott asked about doing a walkthrough at the Galleria this fall*.
