Technical Proposals may be rejected if the requirements are not provided in accordance with the Request for Proposal (RFP). The County reserves the right to determine, at its sole discretion, if the Proposal responses meet the RFP requirements. Cost Proposals may be rejected if any of the Unit Prices are obviously unbalanced. The County will decide whether any unit prices are unbalanced either excessively above or below a reasonable cost analysis value determined by the Engineer, particularly if these unbalanced amounts are substantial and contrary to the interest on the County.

In an effort to meet Title VI requirements, contractors are encouraged to fill out the form in the bid package. This is strictly voluntary. Please place form in a separate envelope and deliver to Cobb County Procurement Department.

I. QUESTIONS/ANSWERS

- Q. I received an Addendum 1 via Ga Procurement Registry dated 9/22/25. The addendum contains a listing of the pre-bid attendees. Cooper & Company attending virtually, however, we are not listed on the pre-bid sheet. See attached email correspondence confirming our attendance. Please clarify the names of other contractors along with Cooper & Company that attended virtually.
- A. The County is unable to provide a complete list of all entities who chose to attend virtually if they did not respond to the request for contact information. As this information was necessary to mark attendance and Cooper & Company did provide the required information, they were provided access to the Cost Proposal portion of the solicitation.
- Q. Q&A on Addendum 1 dated 9/22/25 notes cut sheets for basis-of-design equipment are provided in an attachment. There is not an attachment on the document.
- A. Per Addendum 1, the cut sheets have been uploaded to BidExpress.
- Q. The RFP states that the costing sheet and other documents were going to be provided after the mandatory meeting to those in attendance. Do you know when these will be posted/sent? We want to make sure we have enough time to properly price out the project, and ask any questions about costing prior to questions being due on Friday.
- A. The TMC Cost Proposal has been sent to the attendees of the mandatory prebid meeting.
- Q. Will you please provide the slide deck presentations that were used today at the pre-bid.
- A. Per Addendum 1, the slide presentation has been uploaded to BidExpress.
- Q. The PM stated that the current TMC operations will continue during construction, but will be moved to a temporary location. Should we include cost for the relocation move in our bid package?
- A. No.
- Q. During the meeting you stated that there will be a RFP and a RFQ released to the public, is this correct?
- A. The TMC Upgrade solicitation has been broken into two parts, each requiring response:
 - The RFP/RFQ will receive the response to the Technical Proposal and was advertised on 8/29/25.
 - The Cost Proposal portion of the solicitation, which will receive bids, was transmitted via invitation to the Contractors/Vendors who were on file as attending the mandatory Pre-Proposal/Pre-Bid meeting.
- Q. Will the RFQ include the computers, network equipment, TVs, switches, converters, furniture, and all others devices?
- A. The Project Manual and Project Drawings detail the material requirements of the solicitation and are available in BidExpress.
