

How to set up a teacher-led Code Club

1. First, head to www.codeclub.org.uk
2. Click the 'register' link in the top right hand corner of the screen.

3. When you reach this screen, choose the 'Host a Club' option on the right.

I want to be a Volunteer


Choose this option if you would like to volunteer at a local community venue using Code Club projects to teach children to code.

I want to be a Club Host

Choose this option if you work at a school, library, museum or community centre and you'd like to find a volunteer to help you start a Code Club. Also choose this option if you're a teacher who would like to run a club yourself at your own school.

4. Next, enter your details. Please use your school email address if you can (this helps our system check you are a teacher). You'll be accepting the Code Club T&Cs at this stage, so make sure you have a read of them before you accept.



7. Next you will be directed to our online training. As we know you are a teacher already, you can skip this if you like. Or why not try it out? Each section takes about 10 minutes and there are 7 sections.

Code Club Training

We've made some online training to equip you with all the know-how you need to run a Code Club.

The training is divided into 7 easy to use sections which explain the basics of coding and how to set up a Code Club.

There are 2 required sections which you need to complete, on how Code Club works and keeping children safe. They should take less than 45 minutes - perfect to dip into during your lunch break or a free period.

Training is optional for Club hosts but we do recommend it.
