

Kids Scavenger Hike: Wild Wonders of Canaan

Recommended ages: 5–12 (with family supervision). Choose a short, kid-friendly trail like Blackwater River, Deer Run, or Cabin Trail.

Wildlife Signs
 □ Animal tracks (any kind — deer, raccoon, rabbit, etc.) □ A deer or signs of deer (scat, hoof prints, rub marks) □ A squirrel or chipmunk gathering food □ A rabbit near brush or hopping through grass □ A bird of prey (hawk or turkey vulture soaring overhead) □ A beaver lodge or gnawed tree
Trees & Plant Life ☐ A maple tree (opposite branching and lobed leaves) ☐ A birch tree (white or peeling bark) ☐ A hemlock tree (flat, soft needles) ☐ A spruce tree (sharp, square needles) ☐ A unique fallen leaf (any color or shape) ☐ Acorns or other nuts
Bonus Challenges ☐ Hear a bird call and try to mimic it! ☐ Spot a colorful mushroom or wildflower (Parents: please do NOT let kids touch mushrooms.) ☐ Find a feather on the ground ☐ Take a family 'Explorer Selfie' at your favorite trail stop!

Safety note: Please do NOT let children touch mushrooms — many are poisonous.
