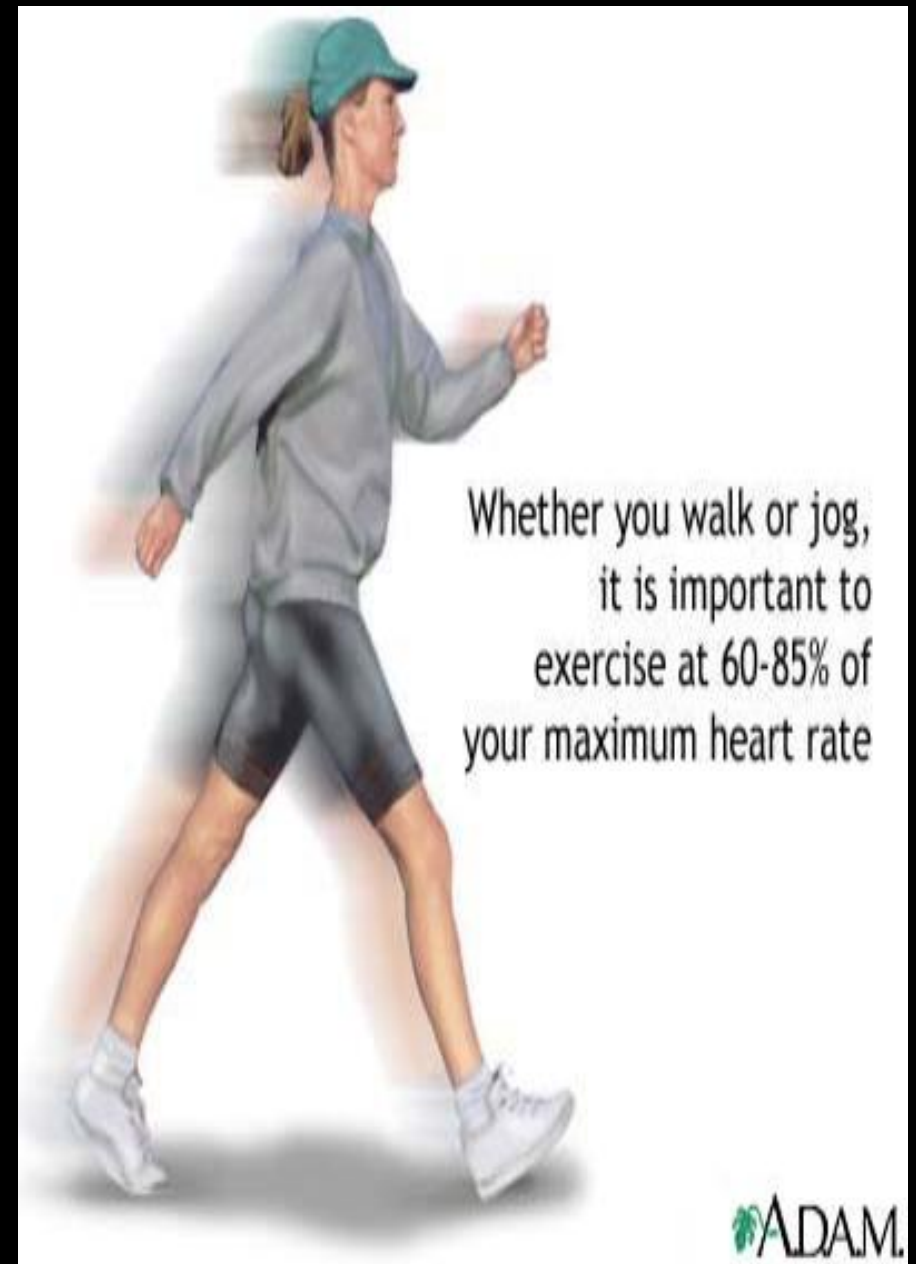
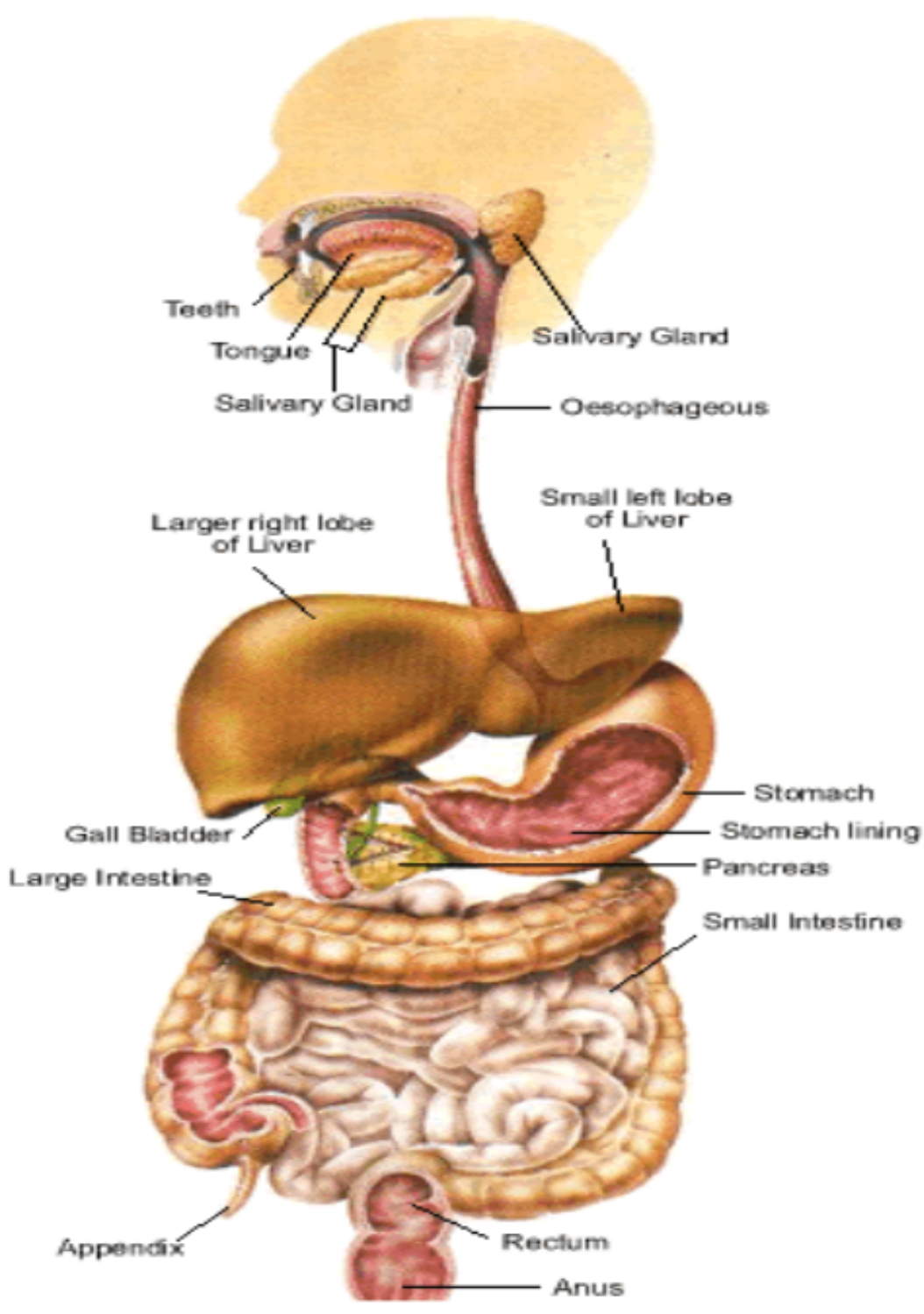

Appropriating the word quickened to us

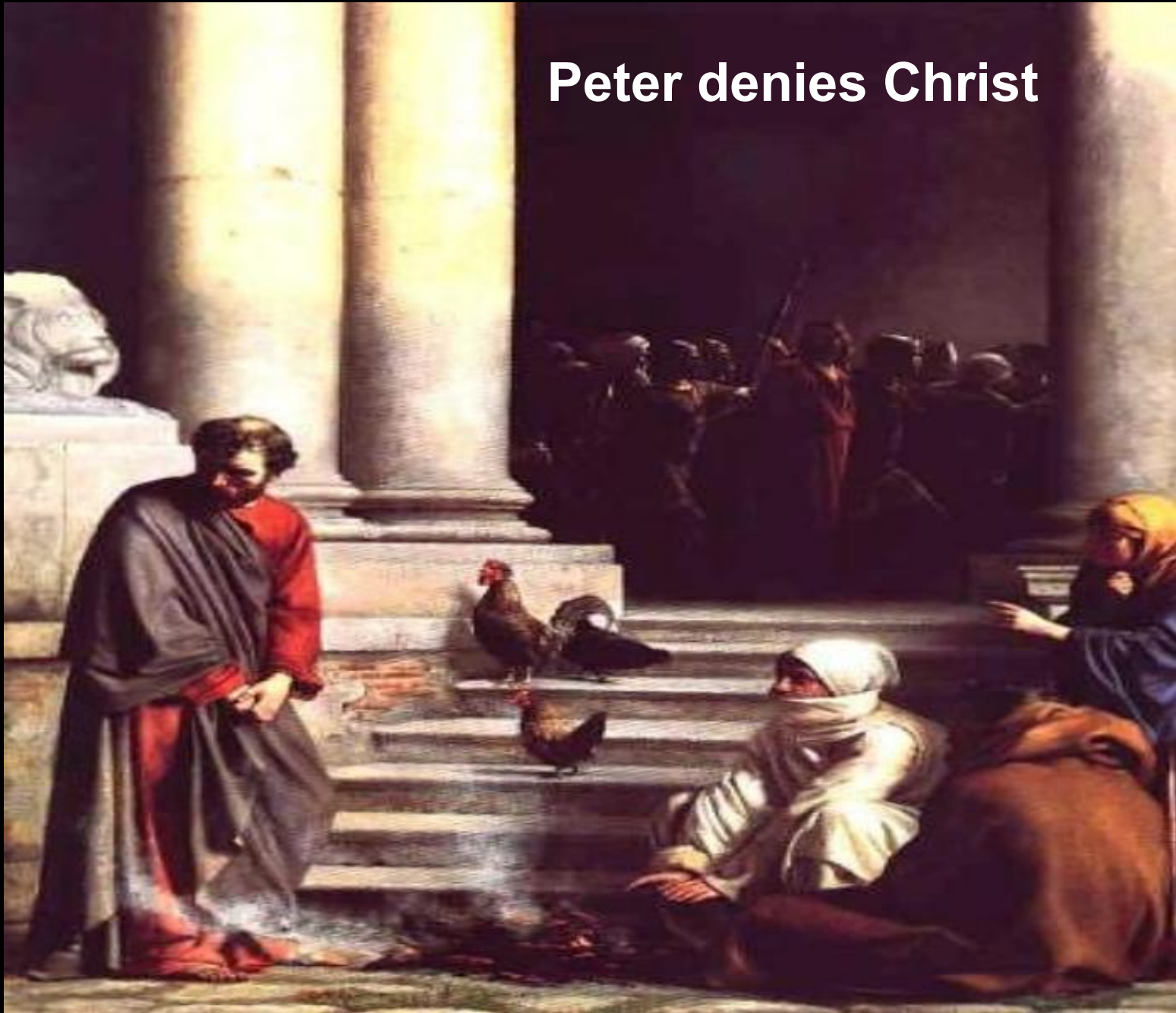
