Civil Docket Fee:	To be collected prior to filing any civil lawsuit. NMSA 1978, § 35-6-1	\$72.00
Civil Jury Fee:	To be collected from the party demanding trial by jury in any civil action at the time the demand is filed or made. NMSA 1978, § 35-6-1	\$25.00
Civil Jury Costs:	Shall be charged against the Party requesting the jury in a civil action. A deposit will be charged and used for payment of the actual costs of empaneling the jury. NMSA 1978, § 35-8-7 and Rule 3-602 NMRA.....	\$75.00
Mediation Fee:	To be collected upon filing small claims lawsuits. NMSA 1978, § 35-6-1	\$5.00

APPLIES TO BOTH CIVIL AND CRIMINAL CASES

Copying Fee:	For making and certifying copies of any records in the Court, for each page copied by photographic process. NMSA 1978, § 35-6-1	\$0.50
Copying Fee:	For computer-generated or electronically-transferred copies, per page. NMSA 1978, § 35-6-1	\$1.00
Civil/Criminal Warrant Fee:	Upon issuance of a bench warrant, an administrative fee is assessed against the individual whose arrest is commanded by the bench warrant. NMSA 1978, § 34-8A-12	\$100.00

APPLIES TO CRIMINAL CASES ONLY

Criminal Docket Fee:	To be collected from every defendant found guilty of a criminal charge, either after trial or a guilty or no contest plea (including traffic offenses, but not including uncontested penalty assessment misdemeanors). NMSA 1978, § 35-6-1	\$20.00

The following are to be collected from persons convicted of violating any provision of the Motor Vehicle Code involving the operation of a motor vehicle, convicted of a crime constituting a misdemeanor or a petty misdemeanor or convicted of violating any ordinance that may be enforced by the imposition of a term of imprisonment:

A person convicted of a violation of NMSA 1978, § 66-8-102 or a violation of a municipal ordinance that prohibits driving while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs shall be assessed by the Court, in addition to any other fee or fine:

Lab Fee:	To defray the costs of chemical and other tests used to determine the influence of liquor or drugs. NMSA 1978, § 31-12-7	\$85.00
DWI Prevention Fee:	To fund comprehensive programs for the prevention of driving while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs and for other traffic safety purposes. NMSA 1978, § 31-12-7	\$75.00

Lab Fee:	To be collected from persons convicted of a violation of the controlled substances act or similar municipal ordinance to defray the costs of chemical and other analyses of controlled substances. NMSA 1978, § 31-12-8	\$75.00

Brain Injury Services Fee:	To be collected upon conviction from persons convicted of violating any provision of the of the Motor Vehicle Code involving the operation of a motor vehicle. NMSA 1978, §§ 66-8-116.3 and 35-6-1.D.....	\$5.00

Traffic Safety Fee:	To be collected upon conviction from persons convicted of violating any provision of the Motor Vehicle Code. NMSA 1978, §§ 66-8-116.3 and 35-6-1.D	\$3.00

Domestic Violence Treatment Fee:	To be collected upon conviction from a person convicted of a penalty assessment misdemeanor, traffic violation, or petty misdemeanor offense. NMSA 1978, § 31-12-11	\$5.00

Juvenile Adjudication Fee:	To be collected upon conviction from a person convicted of a penalty assessment misdemeanor. NMSA 1978, § 66-8-116.3.....	\$1.00
