How it works

Administrators can add integration with the organization's Victor system (adding a new system) and reduce the need to manage devices via CSV.

Horizon's new integration with CCure allows Horizon to retrieve data from CCure. When an endpoint is defined, Horizon first retrieves your device's information. The data is then processed and transferred to the Horizon platform, which can monitor devices in real-time. Once the device is part of Horizon, you can enjoy Horizon's full capabilities: geolocation, groups, analytics etc.

Prerequisite

- Victor supported integration version
- Licence for SecuriThings-CCure integration
- Establish connectivity between Horizon Connector and Victor server (ACLs)

Configure the Integration

CCure

- Enable Victor Web Service
- Define a user for SecuriThings integration

Horizon

- Login into Horizon (Admin permission required)
- Under Horizon connector section select add source
- Select the integration with CCURE9000
- Fill in the following information: Server Host, Port to communicate with CCure server, Credentials, Protocol
- Submit to begin the discovery process
