From the hand with 2 tissues, toss one tissue in the air. When that tissue is at its peak, toss the tissue from the opposite hand in the air. Catch the first tissue with the empty hand. Toss the remaining tissue in the air. Catch the tissue. Continue to toss tissues in air with one hand catching each tissue with the opposite hand.
