- **David J. Sencer CDC Museum** (<http://www.cdc.gov/museum/>) – Award-winning permanent and changing exhibitions that focus on a variety of public health topics. Free and open to the public. Reservations required for groups of 10 or more.
- **CDC Junior Disease Detectives Summer Camp** (<http://www.cdc.gov/museum/camp/junior/index.htm>) 3-day educational program for rising 7th and 8th graders.
