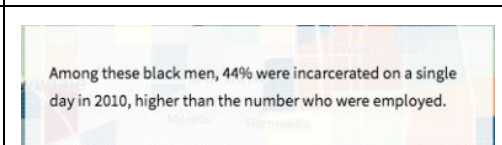

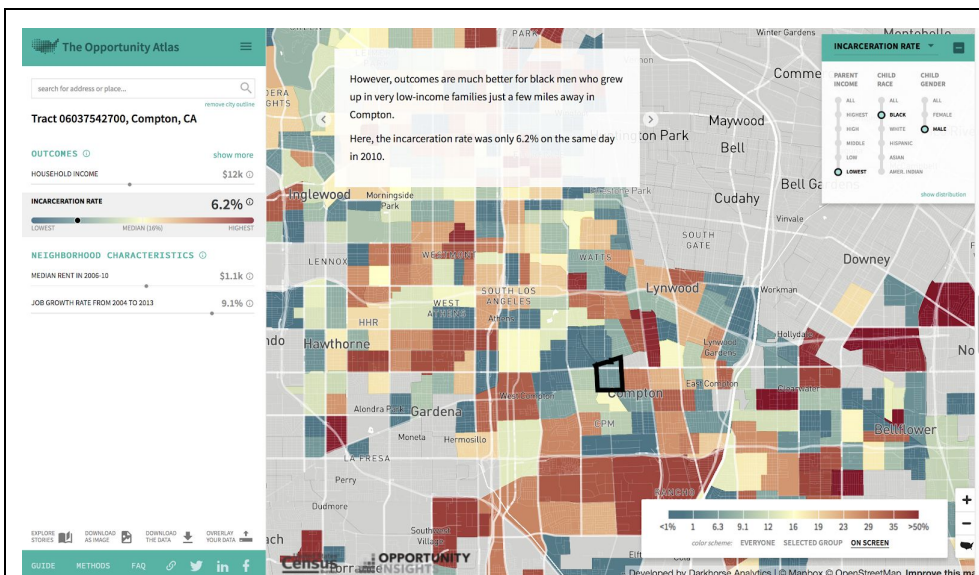

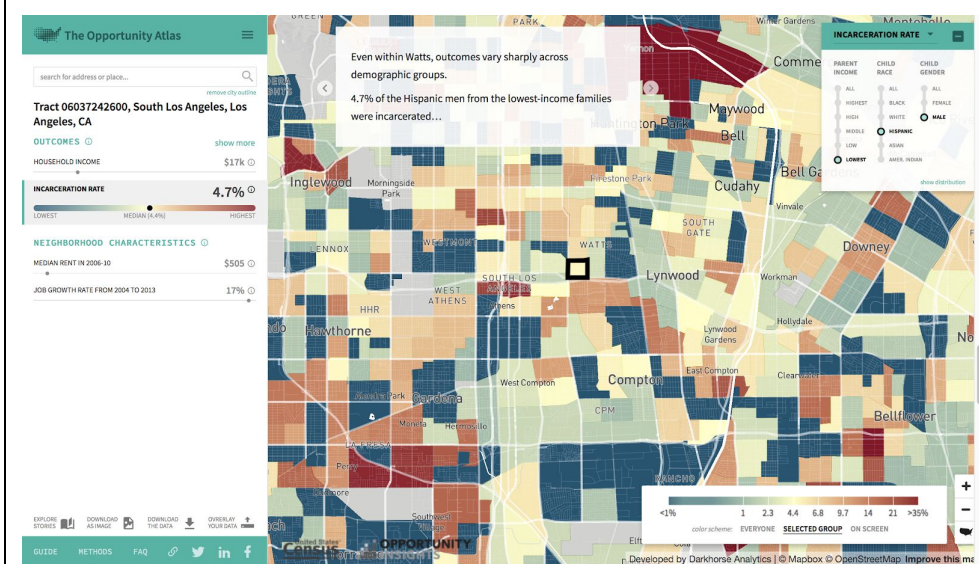

However, outcomes are much better for black men who grew up in very low-income families just a few miles away in Compton.

Here, the incarceration rate was only 6.2% on the same day in 2010.

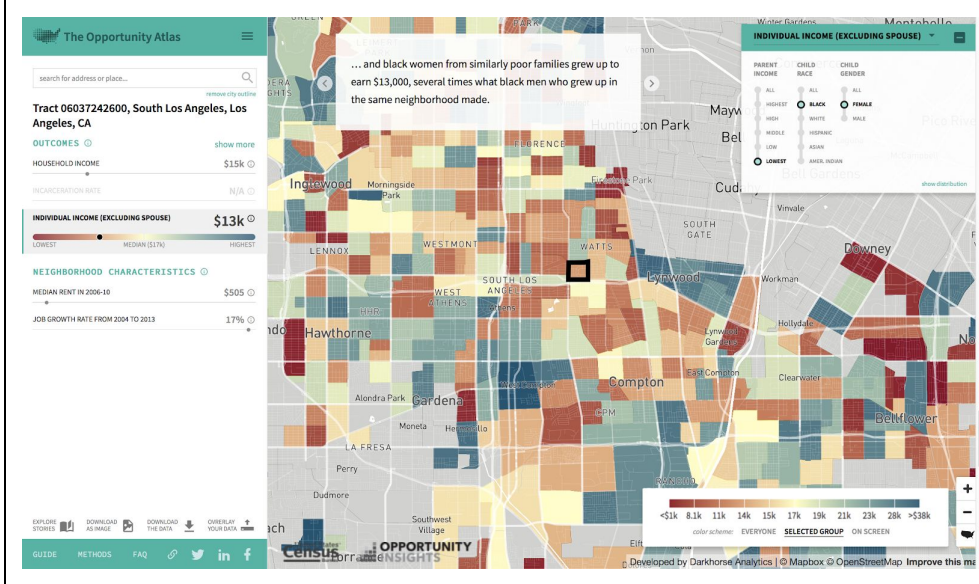

Even within Watts, outcomes vary sharply across demographic groups.

4.7% of the Hispanic men from the lowest-income families were incarcerated...

... and black women from similarly poor families grew up to earn \$13,000, several times what black men who grew up in the same neighborhood made.
