Stronger Clearer Each Time!

Stronger Clearer Protocol

- Teacher gives prompt for an original response.
- Students work independently to formulate their response.
- Successive partners: borrow and use the language, ideas, and evidence each time. Responses become stronger (often longer) with better supporting evidence and examples.
 - Students say idea to two or more successive listeners
 - Make their idea stronger each time, with more and better evidence and explanation
- Responses become clearer with more precise terms and linked, organized, complete sentences.
 - Students make their idea **clearer** each time by using complete sentences, transitions, precise vocabulary, etc.
- Scaffolds are reduced during the activity.
 - Students use scaffolds

 (notes, visuals) less and
 less each time they talk to
 a new partner.
