Discussion Protocol

- Each group member has a different color of linker cubes.
- Teacher poses a discussion question for partners or small groups to discuss.
- Once a member shares a thought, they place their cube in the middle of the table.
- If a different member's thought builds on a shared idea, they place their cube on top.
- If the thought does not build on, they place the cube in the middle of the table but not on top.

Talking Sticks



"Talking Stick" protocol for holding a small-group discussion.

- Place your "Talking Stick" (could be a pen or pencil) in the center of your desks
- 2. The person who wants to talk first picks up the talking stick from the center of the table and shares his/her ideas.
- 3. When s/he is done, the talking stick is set down in front of him/her so the next person can pick up the stick to talk.
- 4. When all group members have taken a turn, place the sticks back in the center.
- 5. Each person must make one comment before any person can make a second or third comment.
