"I will play with my train while I wait for the rain to be **done**," says Jay.



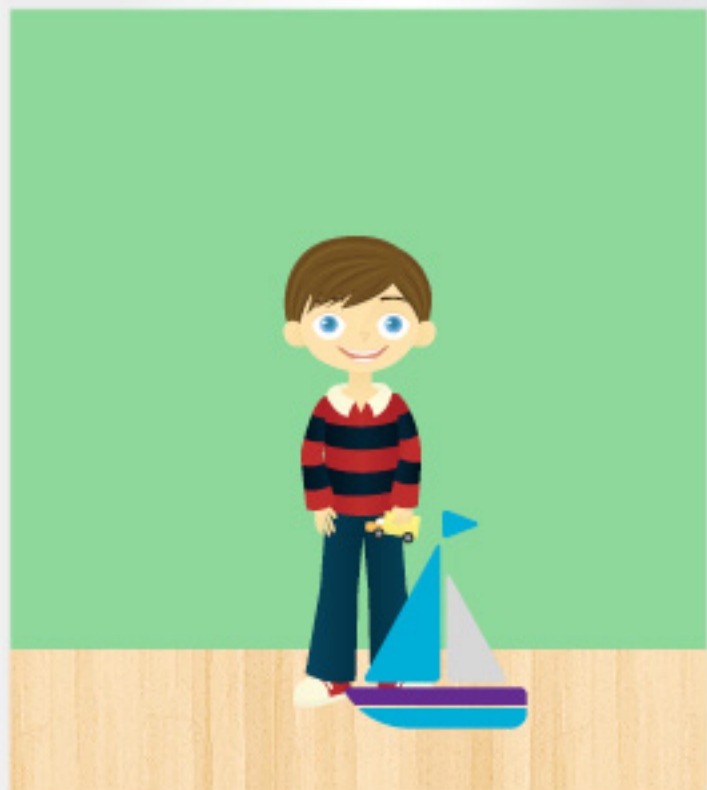

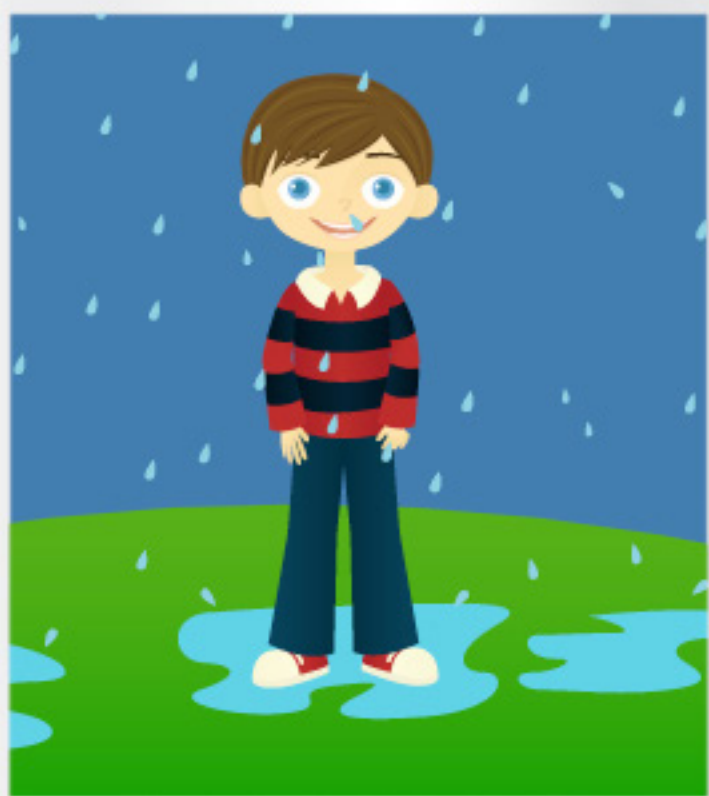
Jay asks his mom, "Is the rain **done** yet? It has **been** raining for so long."
