

ELA2 Phonics and Sight Words Synchronous Assessment Recording Sheet

Below is a recording sheet that goes along with the Power Point Presentation titled: ELA2 Synchronous Assessment 1. Record each of your student's responses from the assessment on this document. Follow these directions below while testing your students:

Introduction, read to students

I am so excited for you to show me what you've learned so far about phonics and sight words. I will show you a letter sound and then ask you to sound it out and give me a word that uses that sound.

Part One: Phonics

Slides 3-11, read to students:

1. What sound does this make?
 2. What is a word that uses that sound?
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Scoring Students:

- **Phonics Recognition:** Write a Y next to each phonics sound the student produces the correct sound for and an N if the sound is incorrect. Make any notes that will help identify confusion - for example, if a student produces the short a sound instead of the long a.
- **Words That Use that Sound:** Write a Y next to each phonics sound the student names a word that uses it and an N next to each letter with an incorrect (or no) word. Write the word the student says.

Part Two: Sight Words

Introduction, read to students:

Now you get to read me your sight words.

Slides 13-27, read to students:

What word is this?

Scoring Students:

- **Word Recognition:** Write a Y next to each word the student reads correctly and an N next to each letter incorrectly identified. If incorrect, indicate the word that was said.
