How to determine and assign a student's reading level.

Determining Level:

- 1. Once logged in, click on the blue Resources button.
- 2. Click on Assessments on the left.
- 3. Click on Benchmark Passages & Running Records.
- 4. If you know the student's reading level, select a story on that level.

 If you are unsure of the student's level, choose a story under P.
- 5. Click *Read* and ask the student to read the passage aloud to you.

Determine the accuracy rate. (total words - total errors) / total words x 100

If the student has an accuracy rate of at least 90%, click on the Quiz and have the student answer the questions.
