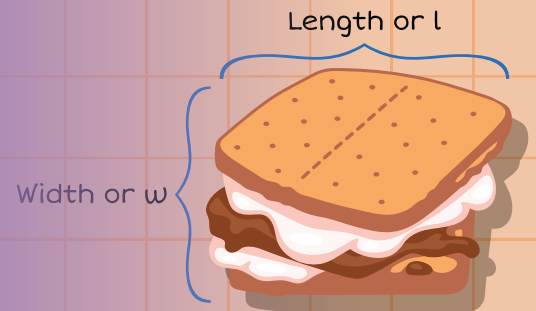

# Multiply Side Lengths to Find the Area

5 cm

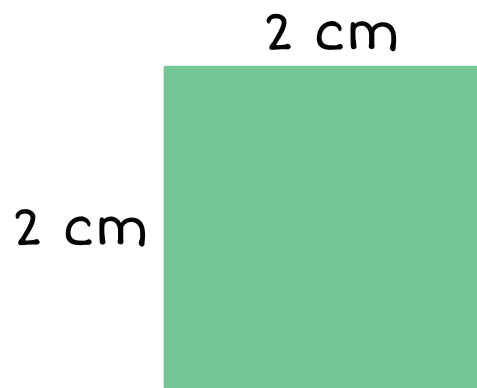


3 cm

$$3 \text{ cm} \times 5 \text{ cm} = 15 \text{ square cm}$$

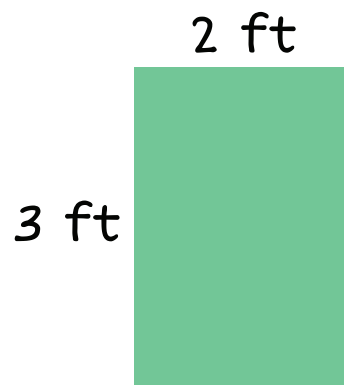
