

You will need a number line, a game pawn, and a number die.

- 1. Roll the die and place your game pawn on the number rolled.
- 2. Roll the die again and add the number you rolled to the number you are on.
- 3. Write down the addition sentence you made.
- 4. Repeat the steps until you have filled in all the problems on your recording sheet.
- 5. Circle the problems that equal 10 on your recording sheet.
- 6. If you are playing against someone the person with the most additions sentences that equal 10 wins the game.

Sample Play:

Roll I:

You rolled a 5 so you put your game marker on the 5.

Roll 2: (● ●)

You rolled a 4 so now you move your game marker 4 spaces.
