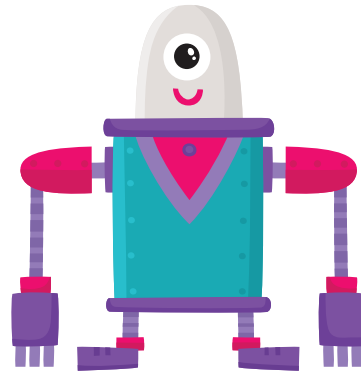

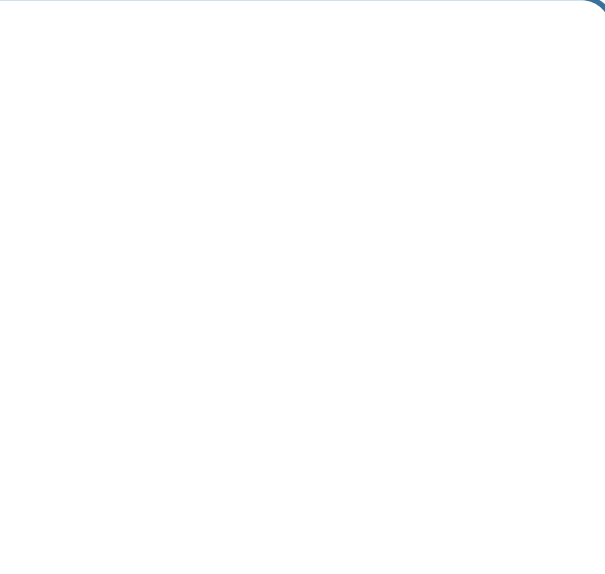

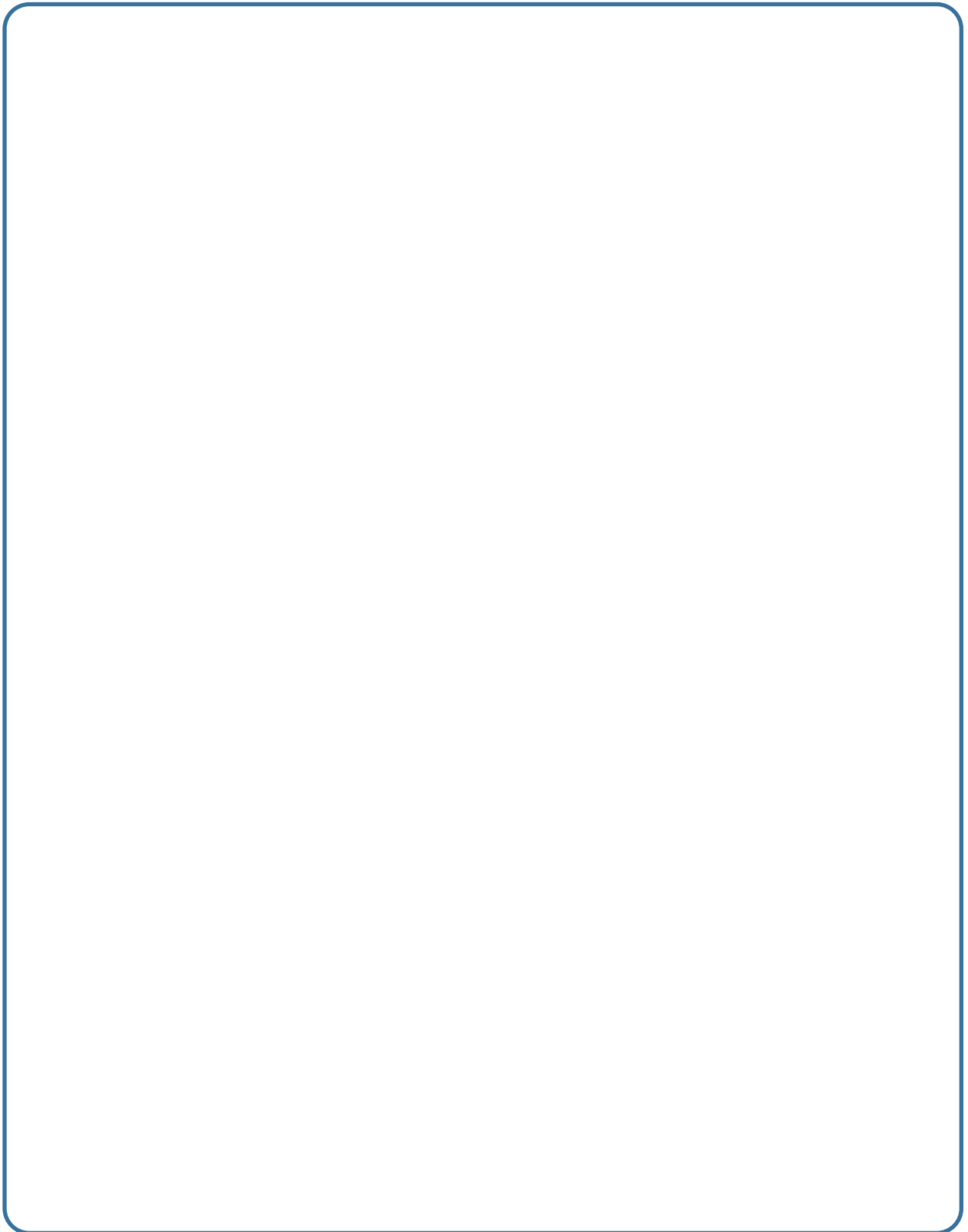
2. Circle examples of safety. Then, draw an X on unsafe things.
