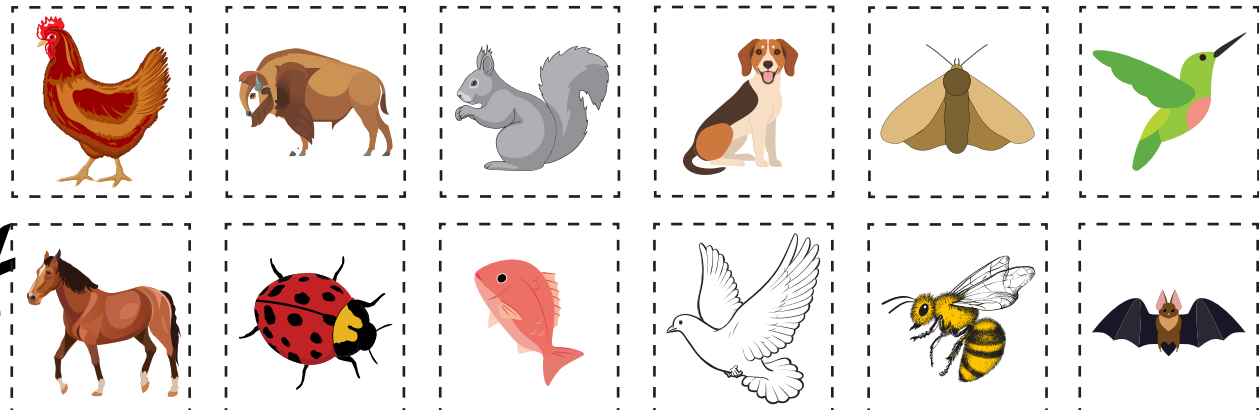

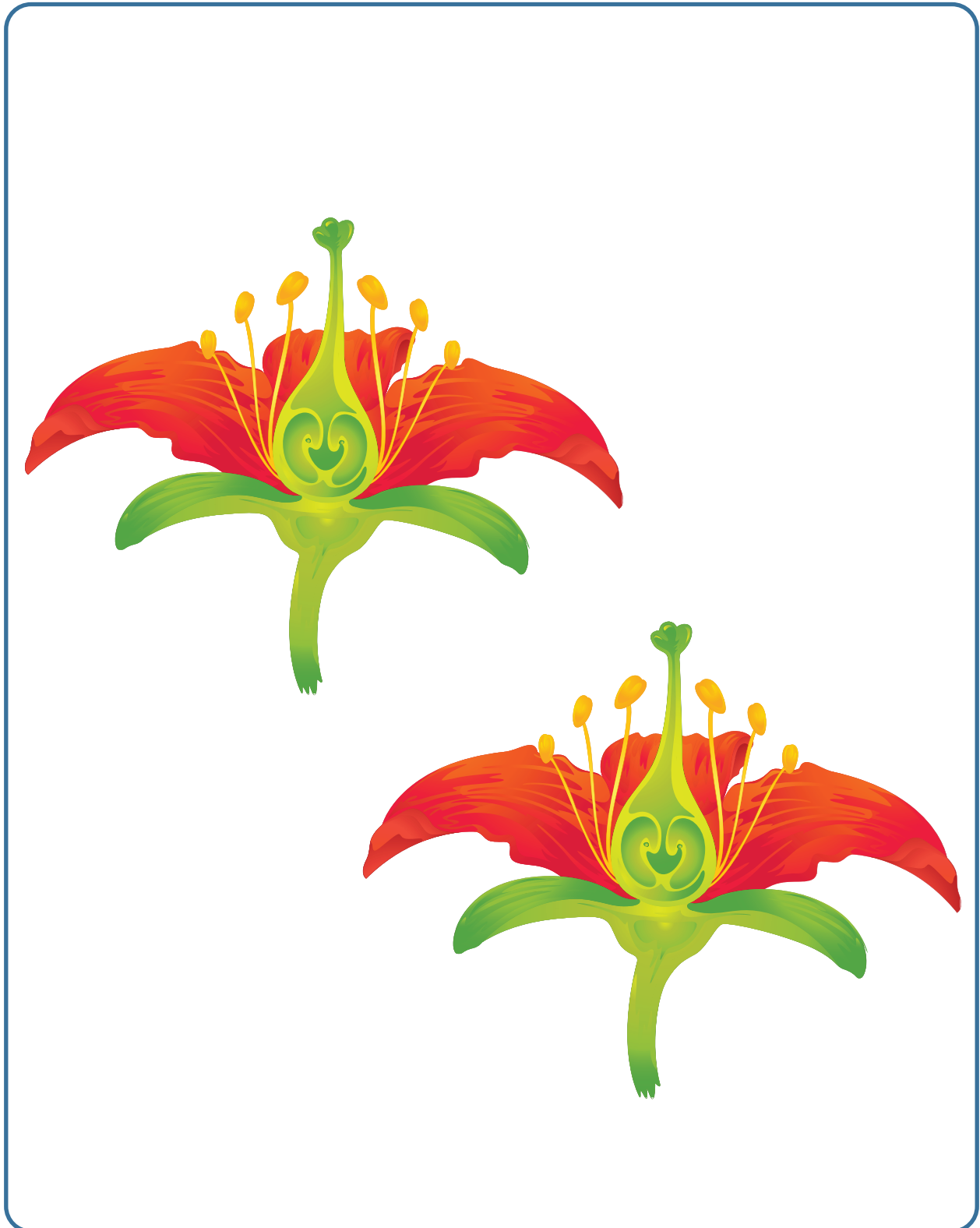
I. Which ones are pollinators?
