I attended the following horse at BW Pearson Horse Breaking in Connewarre, Victoria on Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> August 2019.

Breeding: By Contributor (IRE) from Shades Of Silk (AUS) 2017, a 2-year-old filly

Description: Unnamed (NZ) bay Thoroughbred filly; star, off hind fetlock.

This evaluation included a general physical and lameness examination including evaluation at the walk, trot and canter. Electrocardiography, endoscopy and radiography were neither requested nor performed.

The horse was found to be in good health and physical condition. No abnormalities were detected on auscultation of heart, lungs and digestive tract. Temperature was 38.3 degC. No abnormalities were detected on palpation and flexion of the limbs. There was a skin wound on the chest, between the pectoral muscles that had some surrounding oedema. There was no discharge from the wound and it did not appear to be causing any discomfort to the horse. It was considered likely that the wound would heal unremarkably and not affect the athletic potential of this horse.


No response was detected on hoof tester evaluation. There was no evidence of lameness at the walk and trot, and the horse moved freely at the trot and canter. The horse did not lock her stifle while being exercised.

Based on my examination at this time, assuming that the chest wound heals as expected, I consider the horse to be suitable for sale as a racehorse.

I certify that I have no current interest nor do I anticipate future interest in the above described filly other than in the supply of this veterinary opinion of suitability for racing.
