


Race an Impressive HINCHINBROOK 2-Year-Old



By Australian Champion 1st Season Sire

HINCHINBROOK

A three-quarter brother to **Group 1** winner and leading sire **SNITZEL** and Group I winner Viennese, Hinchinbrook is by Champion Sire **FASTNET ROCK** from stakes-winning sprinter Snippets' Lass.

Hinchinbrook was a top class juvenile, winning the Group 3 AJC Skyline Stakes and Listed Canonbury Stakes before being the first colt home when fourth to Crystal Lily in the Group I STC Golden Slipper and followed up for third in the **Group I** AJC Sires Produce Stakes. He trained on at three years for Group I placings in the AJC All Aged Stakes, MRC Oakleigh Plate and MVRC William Reid Stakes before being retired due to injury.

Hinchinbrook was **Leading Australian First Season Sire 2014/15**. His progeny includes **PRESS STATEMENT** (now at stud) – winner of the **Group 1** Caulfield Guineas, the Hobartville Stakes, the JJ Atkins Stakes; recent 2yo **Group 1** Champagne Stakes winner **SEABROOK** and the **Group 1** HK International Sprint; winner **BEAT THE CLOCK**; Group 2 winners **WHISPERING BROOK, BEAT THE CLOCK, DIAMOND TATHAGATA, DERRYN, SALSONIC** and **SAMARA DANCER**; and Group 3 winners **FLIPPANT, SPRIGHT** and **FLYING JESS**.

A Hinchinbrook colt, **UNITE AND CONQUER**, won the 2019 Wyong Magic Millions Classic while a 4yo Hinchinbrook mare **PROBLEM SOLVER** won the Magic Millions Wyong 3 & 4yo Stakes on the same day in December.

Hinchinbrook's yearlings have sold for up to A\$1 million.



The Hinchinbrook – Watch My Toosh Gelding

From a Female Family Littered with Sires

This horse's dam **Watch My Toosh** is a daughter of Australian Champion Broodmare Sire, **ENCOSTA DE LAGO**. He earned this title in both 2015-16 and 2016-17. Encosta de Lago is currently sire of the dams of 1821 runners for 1084 winners, including **45 Group winners**.

Watch My Toosh's pedigree carries plenty of top drawer black type, with **Group 1 winners EMERALD DREAM, SHOOTING TO WIN** (now at stud), **LA LUNA ROSSA** and successful sires **DANEWIN** and **COMMANDS** on her catalogue page. Exciting Group 2 winning first season sire **DEEP FIELD** is also present.

Like Watch My Toosh, Deep Field and Shooting to Win have Encosta de Lago on their sire lines, making her very similarly bred to these two top class racehorses.

Further Pedigree Notes:

The tail female family of this gelding traces to the legendary producer, **EIGHT CARAT**. Not only are the abovementioned members in the gelding's immediate family descendants of Eight Carat, but also key Australasian sire influences such as **OCTAGONAL, KAAPSTAD, MOUAWAD, KEMPINSKY** and **VIKING RULER**.

The Trainer

The gelding will be trained by [Jarrod Austin](#) of Austin Racing Stables, Warwick Farm. Jarrod was a vital part of the selection process for this horse.

Great consideration was given not only to conformation, but also the compatibility of sire and dam as a pre-requisite to the short-listing of suitable types to inspect.

"This fellow caught my eye as a big, strong type with a lovely walk and he ran a good time at the Ready2Run Sale. Obviously his sire is very appealing and he comes from a great colt's family. His x-rays were squeaky clean and he presented with a good attitude." (Jarrod Austin)

In the Sydney training ranks, Jarrod would be categorised as a 'boutique trainer', currently having a stable of about twenty horses in work. Jarrod's life long experience in the racing industry - including as a private trainer - met with instant success when he decided to establish himself as a public trainer.

Commencing in 2011 with a 'handful' of horses, he achieved a Sydney city double including a **stakes win** in his first season, along with many city and provincial winners.

Jarrod has enjoyed success with stakes horses such as **TERRITORY**, **URQUIDEZ** and **SPINNAWITCH** and has regularly been in the winners' circle with members of his stable such as Raijinz, Kelvinside, Magnajoy, Hit The Mark, Napoleon, Blazing Beau, Manhattan Chic, Sophia's Charm, Carluca and Hirokin. Jarrod is now developing a team of well bred, promising two- and three-year-olds that should further enhance his win strike rate.

Jarrod Austin has a decidedly hands on approach, with the philosophy that in order to realise each horse's best potential, it should be **happy, healthy and fighting fit**. They receive highly individual and specialised care which, combined with a dedicated professional team, patience and hard work, make up the key ingredients of Austin Racing's successful formula.

While Jarrod's horses have every advantage with the training facilities at Warwick Farm, his reputation as a genuine horseman is widely known and consequently, the quality of his young stock has risen as he attracts the attention of owners and industry participants.

The Syndication

A partnership is being formed and buyers are welcome to take from 2.5% upwards, subject to availability. Enquire regarding percentage prices.

Ongoing Costs

Commencing 1st January, each shareholder will be invoiced. It will combine the invoices for training, agistment, farrier and veterinary fees **for the preceding month**.

We do not add a margin to invoiced provider costs.

Jarrold Austin's daily training fee is \$93.50 per day plus GST. Other fees when a horse is in full work include track fees, medications, nominations, transport to races, strapper's fee, etc. Cost per month while in work can be between \$220 and \$280 per 5% while actually racing, but will be less when in training in the weeks prior to racing.

The horse will spell at Jazcom Thoroughbreds at The Oaks. Their standard monthly fee is currently around \$925, which is approximately \$46 per 5% share.

Naming

Once all shares have been sold, we will call for your name suggestions. Each owner will be entitled to the submission of one name suggestion.

A vote will be held to select the three names to be submitted to the Registrar of Racehorses.

Prizemoney

All net prizemoney will be paid direct by Racing NSW into the individual shareholders' nominated bank accounts after each race. Austin Racing does not take any percentage of the prizemoney other than for the individual share we may own in the horse.
