Discussion Questions

- **1.** The kids say honor is "when you show respect for someone" and "when you praise someone for something good they did." How do you define honor?
- 2. The kids give examples of the people they honor (parents, friends, brother, etc.). Who do you honor? Why?
- **3.** One girl says she honors those who serve in the military "because they protect our country." Do you agree or disagree with her? Explain your answer.
- **4.** What are some ways to show you honor a person or a group of people?
- 5. What does it mean to be honorable?
- **6.** Another girl says, "If you are honorable you can be a good leader." Do you have to be honorable to be a good leader? Why or why not?
