## Student Reflection Page: Lakeysha

### Grade Level: PreK-2

Complete this reflection page after watching the Deeper Look video: Lakeysha. In this piece, Lakeysha speaks from her heart about other kids who bully kids in special education classes and how popular kids bully others. Write a sentence or draw a picture that responds to each question.

1. Lakeysha says that bullies call kids in special education classes “dumb,” but we know that people in special education classes just learn differently. How can you nicely tell a person that it is wrong to call another person “dumb”?

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2. Lakeysha says that bullies are “scary.” Does she mean scary like monsters are scary? What do you think she means? Draw a picture of a scary bully. What could you add to the picture to show how scary bullies are not allowed in your school?

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3. The video ends with Lakeysha talking about how popular kids “tease other people who don’t look popular” or who are not popular like they are. What does it mean to be popular? Why is it wrong for popular kids — or anybody — to bully people who are not popular? What should popular kids — and all kids — do instead of bullying people?

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
