Video Title: **Empathy, Relationship Skills**

Grade Level: **High School**

Pre-Viewing: Before watching the video...

1. How do you define generosity? Other than sharing money or spending time with others, what are some other ways to show generosity?
2. How important is generosity as a character trait? What other character traits might influence or have an impact on generosity?
3. How might school be different if everyone practiced generosity?
4. Is there someone who is generous to you with time, talent, or treasure? How does that person's generosity make a difference in your life?

Discussion Questions: After you watch the video...

1. How is generosity inferred in this film?
2. 160,000 students like Danielle stay home from school because they are afraid. What forms of generosity would it take on the part of someone your age to help at least one of these people come to school?
3. How did Danielle's mother and father's relationship become "one long fight" with her?
4. What do you think pushed her mother to seek the generosity of others and ask for help?
5. Some people might say that it is Mrs. Berrios's job to help Danielle. Build an argument for how her actions show generosity to Danielle.
6. How might Danielle's school experience have been different if other people in school practiced generosity?
7. Create a scenario where everyone in your school suddenly felt the need to be generous to each other. What would that look like? Sound like? Would it be fictional or real? Why?
