I, J R JENCKS, being first duly sworn and upon oath, depose and
state as follows:

I am a Police Lieutenant employed by the Bethany Police Department, City of
Bethany, County of Oklahoma County, assigned to the Patrol Division.

That on October 13, 2011 the Bethany Police responded to a call of suspicious
odor in the 7100 blk of NW 23rd in the City of Bethany. Upon arrival Officers
found that a human female body had been dumped in a field a short distance from
the Homeland grocery store located there. The body had been dismembered and
placed in a bag. During the investigation the identity of the body was
confirmed by the Medical Examiners office from tatoos and dental records as
that of 19 year old Carina Brianne Saunders. Saunders had been reported as a
missing person from Oklahoma City in early October 2011.

During the course of the investigation it was determined that there had been a
witness to the incident resulting in the death of Saunders. That witness was
located and gave a statement in reference to the incident. In October, late on
the 9th and early into the 10th, 2011 the witness had been standing in the
street near the residence where she had been staying in NW Oklahoma City, in
Oklahoma County. At that time a vehicle drove up and the door opened and a
white male subject grabbed the witness and pulled her into the vehicle and it
drove away. The victim stated that she had been blindfolded with "some type of
dark handkerchief." The vehicle drove to a location where she was taken into a
room and held forcibly and made to watch the torture of a white female. The
witness stated that she did not know the victim but later recognized her from
the television as Carina Saunders. The female was given a message to relay to
her associates that this is what happens to people who don't cooperate. The
female witness was later released. Additional witnesses were contacted and
confirmed that they were contacted by the female kidnap victim and responded to
her request to pick her up after she had been released. Those witnesses
confirm that the kidnap victim was in a state of extreme shock and had very
distinct bruises on both arms in the shape of hand and finger prints.

The investigation continued and the name of a person of interest, Jimmy MASSEY,
who also goes by the nickname of "Big County" or "Country" was named as being
involved in the Homicide. Information was given to the Bethany Police that
Jimmy MASSEY, "Big County" was also the focus of a large narcotics
investigation being conducted by a narcotics task force. As a result of that
investigation there was a warrant for the arrest of Jimmy MASSEY, aka "Big
Country", date of birth 07-20-78 on Drug Trafficking and Conspiracy charges.
On November 4, 2011, Officers of the Bethany Police, Oklahoma City Police, and
Oklahoma County Sheriff's Department contacted several persons and were able to
locate Jimmy MASSEY near SW 29th and I-44. MASSEY had been in a vehicle but
now was attempting to flee the area on foot west bound when he was located and
taken into custody in the 3500 blk of NW 29th by members of the OCPD and
Bethany Police Department at approximately 1918 hours.

MASSEY was transported to the Bethany Police Department and read his Miranda Warning and Rights. MASSEY waived his Miranda Warning and Rights and agreed to talk to officers about all incidents. During the interrogation MASSEY admitted to being the subject that had been in the vehicle in NW Oklahoma City and pulled up to same address listed by the Kidnap victim and opened the door and reached out and grabbed the victim. MASSEY stated that the victim was blindfolded with, "some type of dark handkerchief." MASSEY called the victim by her name. The kidnap victim was brought to the Bethany Police Department and MASSEY actually physically saw and identified the kidnap victim as the person he had grabbed and pulled into the vehicle and called her by her name. MASSEY further stated that he had been the person that took the kidnap victim to the room and held her, forcing her to watch the torture and subsequent death of a white female. MASSEY positively identified photographs of Carina Brianne Saunders as the female that had been in the room and had been tortured and killed. MASSEY went on to describe very specific and graphic details about how the body of Saunders had been tortured and finally dismembered prior to it's disposal. MASSEY also identified other persons that were involved and present in the room and involved in the murder.

The Kidnap victim was later interviewed again and revealed additional details. The victim stated that Jimmy MASSEY, that she knew as "County", was the subject that grabbed her and took her to the room to watch the torture. The victim stated that the reason she had been taken to the room and forced to watch the torture of the white female was because the group of suspects in the room was sending her a message that she and her associates would facilitate their human trafficking organization or this same fate/treatment would happen to her.

The name of the kidnap victim is being withheld for her safety as there are other suspects still at large.

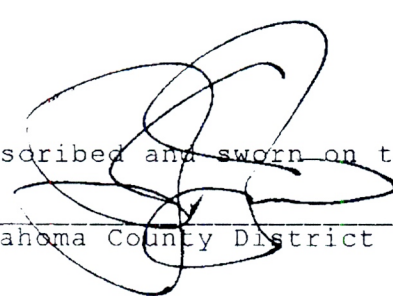
MASSEY was booked into Oklahoma County Jail on the Drug Trafficking warrants and has been there since November 5, 2011. Since then MASSEY has been re-interviewed and through additional channels of communications, has relayed very specific and detailed information about the torture, death, and disposal of the body of Carina Saunders that only a person that was present at the scene and involved with the crime would have knowledge of.

Based on my investigation I believe the DEFENDANT to be guilty of:

- 1) Murder First Degree (Carina Brianne Saunders) O.S. 21 701.7.A,
- 2) Kidnapping (Un-named Female Victim) O.S. 21 741,
- 3) Assault and Battery (Un-named Female Victim O.S. 21 642.
