STALLION SERVICE CONTRACT

This certifies _____, herein referred to as Mare Owner, has engaged one breeding to _____, hereafter known as Stallion, for the 20__ breeding season at \$_____ (\$200 booking fee included) for the following Mare:

- If mare is sent to farm to be bred, Thunder Spirit Ranch strongly encourages Mare Owner to carry equine mortality and loss of use insurance on mare to be bred. If mare is insured please provide Company Name & Policy # _____ and insurance company phone # _____
- Rayna Harrison/Thunder Spirit Ranch, owner-of/agent, for the above named stallion, will here-in be referred to as Stallion Owner. This service is engaged subject to the following:

1. This contract is good for one foal. Multiple foals from the same mare in the same breeding season will require a separate contract and breeding fee for each resulting foal. The only exception to this would be twins that are carried full term and foaled by one mare.
2. A non-refundable booking fee of \$200 from the above breeding fee is payable with this contract. The balance of \$_____ and all unpaid board and veterinarian expenses will be payable upon receipt of an invoice before the mare leaves the farm or before first shipment of cooled or frozen semen is sent. The Stallion Owner requires 48 hours advance notice before the Mare Owner wishes to remove his/her mare(s) from the farm. The mare (s) (and foal, if applicable) shall be released only upon payment in-full of all outstanding invoices including those from the attending veterinarian.
3. A copy of registration papers (both sides) shall be sent to Stallion Owner with this contract and booking fee. If mare is sent to farm to be bred a current Coggins test (within 6 months) shall

accompany the mare. If this is not presented upon a mare's arrival, the Stallion Owner shall have the attending veterinarian test and evaluate at Mare Owner's expense. Mare (and foal, if applicable) will be periodically vaccinated and de-wormed as deemed necessary by the attending veterinarian at Mare Owner's expense.

4. Mare Owner agrees each mare offered for breeding shall be in sound breeding condition and free from any infection or disease. If the Mare is found to be unhealthy or unsound for breeding, Mare Owner may substitute another mare within the same breeding season.

5. Should the above named Stallion die, be sold, or become unfit for service before mare is pronounced in foal, the Mare Owner is entitled to breed their mare to another stallion of equal, or less, breed-fee-value owned by Stallion Owner..

6. The Stallion Owner agrees to diligently try to settle the above named mare and shall have sole discretion of determining the best method of breeding such mare. If, however, the mare does not settle, the Stallion Owner shall be held harmless. Failure by Mare Owner to have mare ultra-sounded for pregnancy status within 30 days of last breeding will void a live foal guarantee.

7. Live foal Guarantee: Live foal means the foal shall stand, nurse, and live for 24 hours. It is understood that if the mare proves barren, aborts her foal, or if foal is stillborn, a return season will be guaranteed for the following year only, providing proper notification is given. Proper notification shall be defined as follows: Receipt of written certification by a licensed veterinarian within seven days of the mare producing a non-viable foal. Mare Owner certifies that such abortion or death did not result from any act or omission of the Owner subsequent to the mare's departure from Stallion Owner.

8. Third year rebreeds are subject to approval by Stallion Owner. If allowed, an additional booking fee plus any increases in the breeding fee will be charged. No live foal guarantee on third year rebreeds.

9. The breeding season for this contract shall begin February 15th of the year dated on this contract. Collection of stallion will be on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. To guarantee shipping of cooled semen, Mare Owner, Agent, or Mare Owner's veterinarian must give at least a 48 hour notice of possible need of semen shipment. Notification of semen shipment must be received by Stallion Owner by 9.00 AM of collection day. Stallion Owner and attending veterinarian will diligently try to provide high quality semen from Stallion to Mare Owner. Should any problem occur with Stallions cooled semen, frozen semen from Stallion will be provided to Mare Owner.

10. A breeder's certificate will be issued to the Mare Owner after all expenses have been paid in full and upon notification of birth of live foal.

11. Waiver of Liability: It is understood that the breeding farm, its owners, employees, and guests shall not be liable for any injury, escape, disability or death of any horse on it's premises.

12. The signing of this contract entitles Stallion Owner to charge 5% monthly interest on all past due invoices. Past due billing is defined as those amounts not paid within 30 days of invoicing.

13. Registered American Quarter Horse (AQHA) and Thoroughbred (Jockey Club) mares only will be bred to Stallion unless otherwise approved by Breeder.

14. This contract is not valid unless completed in full. When Mare Owner signs and returns contract and booking fee to Stallion Owner, it will become a binding contract on both parties, subject to the above terms and conditions.

15. Mare Owner assumes no responsibility for injury, disease, sickness, or death to the Stallion and the Stallion Owner assumes no responsibility for injury, disease, sickness, or death to the Mare.

16. This contract represents the entire agreement between the parties. No other agreement, promises, verbal or implied, is included unless specifically stated in the written contract. The original contract will be kept on file with Thunder Spirit Ranch and a copy provided for Mare Owner. When Mare Owner and Stallion Owner have signed this contract, it will be binding on both parties, subject to the above conditions.
