Klondike Mines Ry.—Application will be made next session of the Dominion Parliament for an act authorizing the company to extend its line to Edmonton, Alta. The line already extends from Dawson, Yukon, towards the Stewart River, and the projected extension would follow the Stewart River Valley, and proceed by the Great and Lesser Slave Lakes to Edmonton. The total length of the line would be about 1,400 miles. It is stated that the company will not ask for a Government subsidy, but will ask that the Dominion Government guarantee its bonds.
