

ELECTRO-MOTIVE COACH SENT TO BRANTFORD

New Equipment to Be Used On Brantford, St. George, Harrisburg Branch of C. N. R.

The first storage battery automotive passenger and light express coach to be employed on the C. N. R. in this region outside of the Toronto district, reached Brantford to-day for use on the Brantford, St. George and Harrisburg line, according to information received at the local depot.

These units have been used with marked success on the Toronto to Oakville line and other lines in the Toronto district, where a fast and frequent service has been needed, and where the traffic has not been sufficient to justify a regular train service. There is a possibility that these units may be employed more extensively throughout Western Ontario if the present cars in use prove consistently successful.

Resolutions requesting a more extensive use of these transportation units are to be presented to the meeting of the Western Ontario United Board meeting next week, which will be forwarded to the C. N. R. headquarters at Montreal, showing a widespread demand for this kind of service through the 14 counties.
