Cars for the Governor-General.—An Ottawa press dispatch of Dec. 3, 1927, stated that an announcement had been made by the Railways and Canals Department respecting the purchase by the Canadian National Ry. of two new railway cars for the Governor-General's use. The statement, which was credited to the Deputy Minister, Graham A. Bell, was as follows: "The two old cars, Cornwall and York, used by previous Governors-General, were of wooden construction. They were, therefore, not only unsafe for their use but a source of danger to all
