COLLISION ON THE GRAND TRUNK

A collision occurred this morning on the Grand Trunk Railway at this station between two freight trains going West. One train standing on the main line was run into by another train following, and supposed to be running at the rate of 25 miles an hour, telescoping the van and one freight car, besides doing considerable damage to the engine. The accident was caused, so it is said, by the carelessness of the engine driver in not seeing the signal until it was too late to stop the train. The driver sustained slight injuries by jumping off the engine.
