**Thessalon and Northern Ry.**—A deputation consisting of A. E. Dymont, A. A. Burke, J. B. Dabie, H. Appleton, of Thessalon, Ont., and W. Greene, of Marquette, Mich., waited on the Minister of Railways at Ottawa, Jan. 10, to ask Government aid towards the construction of this projected railway. The company was incorporated last session of the Ontario Legislature to construct a line from the C.P.R. Algoma branch southeasterly to Thessalon and northeasterly to the Mississagua River. The intention of the company is to construct a line ultimately to the C.P.R. transcontinental line. The Minister of Railways promised consideration of the proposal, favorably commenting on the line southerly to Thessalon. (Mar., 1907, pg. 163).

Thessalon and Northern Ry.—An exten-

tp. The section of the line into Thessalon  
has been built and is being operated by the
