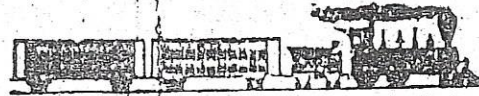

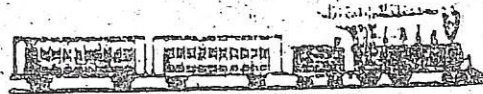

Dressing and Sodding the Slopes of the following Cuttings & Embankments.

1. Between Elgin and Thorold, about 7,000 sq. yds.
2. " Thorold & St. Catharines, 8,000 "
3. " St. Catharines & Jordan, 11,000 "
4. Hamilton Station, about 1,800 "
5. Copetown " 3,000 "
6. Between Hamilton & Wellington Sq. 22,000 "
7. " Bronte and Oakville, 4,000 "
8. " Oakville and Port Credit, 21,000 "
9. Excavating and putting in about 4,000 lineal yards of dry stone drains at foot of slopes of the above cuttings.
10. Excavating and putting in, at the Hamilton Station, about 800 lineal yards of dry stone drains, and

12. " " 850 " " at the Toronto Station.
13. Furnishing requisite stone for said drains.
