LOCOMOTIVE SEIZED.

WHITBY, May 4

A locomotive, purchased for the Port Whitby and Port Perry Railway Company from the Portland Locomotive Company, has been seized at this port, for being entered under value. The engine was purchased at \$11,500, and it was entered at \$4,590. Mr. Warren, the collector of customs, ascertained that three of the same priced locomotives had been entered by the same Company at Port Hope for the Midland Railroad, at \$9,500 each, and so made the seizure, and reported the case to Ottawa. Political influence, it is stated, will be brought to bear on the Government to have the seizure released.
