

# RAIL TIME-TABLE CHANGED SUNDAY

Four New Passenger Trains Are  
Added To Schedule

START "FOREST CITY" TRAIN

Increased Business Expected By  
C.N.R. Officials

Four new passenger trains will be added by the Canadian National Railways and several changes made in the train service commencing to-morrow. The officials in all parts of the division have been notified of the changes which become effective at 12.01 a.m. Sunday.

With a most up-to-date passenger service, Canadian National passenger men predict that the receipts for the month of May will greatly exceed those of the corresponding month of a year ago.

A feature of the alteration in the train service is the addition of a train named the "Forest City," which leaves London at 6 p.m. daily for Montreal, being composed of coaches, standard sleepers, compartment club car, and parlor and dining service.
